



The United States of America To all to whom these presents shall come greeting: Whereas Andrew J. Copey of Lancaster County Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Beatrice Nebraska whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Andrew J. Copey according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24<sup>th</sup> of April 1820 entitled an act making further provisions for the sale of the Public lands further East Half of Section Thirteen and Section Seventy four in Township Three North of Range Two West, in the District of Lands subject to entry at Beatrice Nebraska containing Five Hundred and Sixty acres according to the official Plat of the Surveyor of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said Tract has been purchased by the said Andrew J. Copey. Now know Ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Andrew J. Copey and to his heirs the said tract above described to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatever nature thereto belonging unto the said Andrew J. Copey and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof J. Holmes S. Grant President of the United States of America have caused these Letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the twentieth day of January in the Year of our Lord One Thousand and Eight Hundred and Seventy one and of the Independence of the United States the Twenty fifth.
