

Right of Way Grant

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Dowd Industries Inc.

in consideration of \$35.00 DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, remise, sell and convey unto the City of Schuyler, Nebraska, a municipal corporation, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege, and easement to construct, maintain and operate 34.5 Kilo Volt

ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION LINE through the following described property in the City of Schuyler, Colfax County, Nebraska, to-wit:

To set 7 poles 3 ft. east from the west edge of N¹ of Section 11 Township 17 North Range 3 East of 6th P.M., adjacent to State Highway No. 15.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD to the City of Schuyler, Nebraska, its successors and assigns, so long as such TRANSMISSION LINE

and appurtenances thereto shall be maintained, together with the right of ingress to and egress from said premises, (for the purpose of inspecting, repairing, maintaining and replacing the property of the grantee located thereon, or the removal thereof, in whole or in part, at the will of the grantee); it being the intention of the parties hereto that the grantor... hereby grant... the uses herein specified without divesting the grantor... of the rights to use and enjoy said described premises, subject only to the right of the grantee to use the same for the purposes herein expressed.
