ORDINANCE NO. 16052

01 AN ORDINANCE creating Sewer District No. 1142, providing for the
02 payments of the costs of the improvements constructed therein, designating the
03 property to be benefited, providing for the acquisition of easements and
04 additional right-of-way, if necessary, and repealing all ordinances or parts
05 of ordinances in conflict herewith.

06 BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

07 Section 1. That Sewer District No. 1142 be and the same is hereby
08 created; that said sewer district is created for the purpose of constructing
09 a 12-inch diameter sanitary sewer or sanitary sewers along the north
10 right-of-way line of the Burlington Northern Railroad between West South
11 Street and South Folsom Street, and an 8" diameter sanitary sewer in Southwest
12 9th Street from West South Street north approximately 550.0 feet and in West
13 South Street from Southwest 9th Street to the Burlington Northern Railroad, in
14 said City; and that said district shall include the following described real
15 estate benefited, to-wit: All that portion of Lots 74, 75, 76, 78 and 175
16 lying within 180.0 feet west of the centerline of Southwest 9th Street; all
17 that portion of Lot 64 lying within 150.0 feet northwesterly of the
18 northwesterly line of the Burlington Northern Railroad right-of-way except
19 that portion lying within 190.0 feet west of the centerline of South Folsom
20 Street; all that portion of Lot 82 lying within 150.0 feet northwesterly of
21 the northwesterly line of the Burlington Northern Railroad right-of-way; and
22 all that portion of Lot 173 lying within 180.0 feet east of the centerline of
23 Southwest 9th Street except the north 125.0 feet thereof, all that portion of
24 said Lot 173 lying within 190.0 feet north of the centerline of West South
25 Street, and all that portion of said Lot 173 lying within 150.0 feet
26 northwesterly of the northwesterly line of the Burlington Northern Railroad
27 right-of-way; all Irregular Tracts located in the Northwest Quarter of Section

01 34, Township 10 North, Range 6 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian; and all
 02 that portion of Lot 222 lying within 190.0 feet south of the centerline of
 03 West South Street and lying between the west line extended of Southwest 9th
 04 Street and the northwesterly line of the Burlington Northern Railroad
 05 right-of-way, said Lot 222 is an Irregular Tract located in the Southwest
 06 Quarter of Section 34, Township 10 North, Range 6 East of the Sixth Principal
 07 Meridian; all located in the City of Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska.

08 The cost of the construction of the sewers to accommodate said district
 09 shall be assessed against the property in said district benefited in
 10 proportion to the benefits, not exceeding the cost of said sewers. In the
 11 event that easements or additional right-of-way must be acquired for the
 12 completion of the proposed construction within this district, such property
 13 rights may be acquired by negotiation and purchase or by condemnation, if
 14 necessary, as provided by law.

15 Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict
 16 herewith, be and the same hereby are repealed.

17 Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and
 18 after its passage and publication according to law, but construction shall
 19 not be commenced until ordered by resolution by the City Council.


