greeting: Whereas there has been de-

posited in the General Land Office

of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the

Land Office at Lincoln Nebraska, whereby it appears that,

pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th. May 1862

To secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the Public Domain

and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of William Andrew

has been established and duly consummated, in conformity

to law, for the North East quarter of Section twenty two

in Township eight North of Range one East in the

District of Lands subject to sale at Lincoln Nebraska

containing one hundred and six acres, according to

the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land return-

ed to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now know ye, that there is, therefore, granted by the United

States unto the said William Andrew, the tract of

Land above described: To have and to hold the said tract

of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said

William Andrew, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

Now Testimony whereof, I Rutherford B Hayes,

President of the United States of America have caused

these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the

General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
