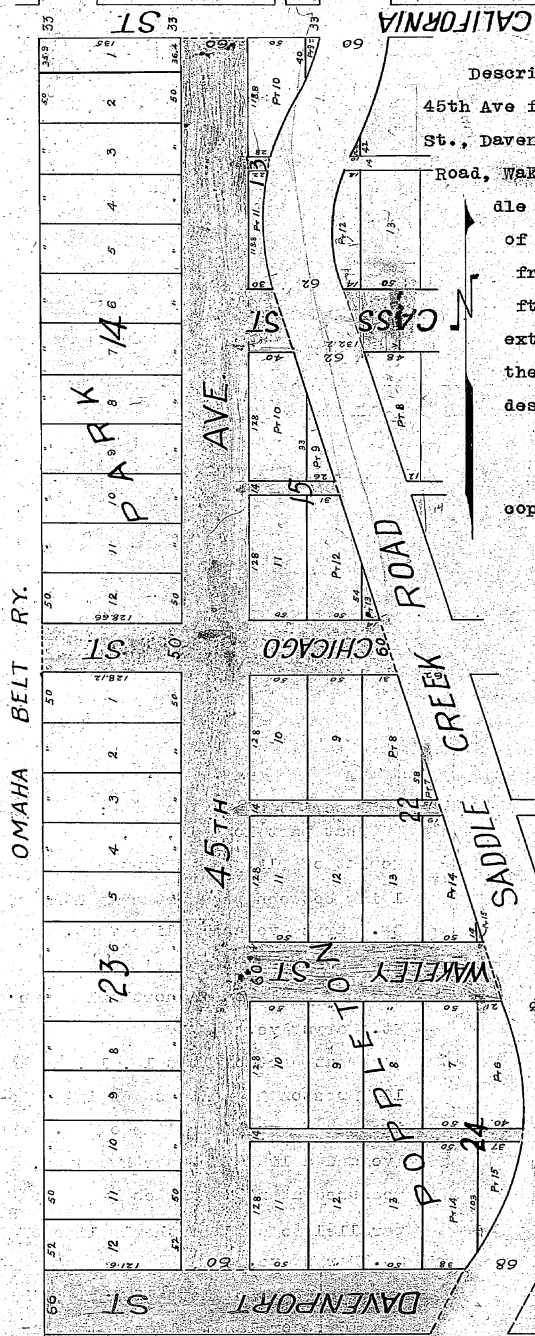

 45th Ave from N.L. of Davenport St. to S.L. of California St., Davenport St from Belt Line E to W.L. of Saddle Creek Road, Wakeley St from E.L. of 45th Ave. to W.L. of Saddle Creek Road, Chicago St. from Belt Line E. to W.L. of Saddle Creek Road, and that part of Cass St. from E.L. of 45th Ave. E. for a distance of 132½ ft., and such parts of each and all part of Alleys extending both E. & W. embraced and included within the Area described by the parts of Streets herein designated.
