In consideration of the construction of its Railway and
the location of its Depot in Emmetsburg, Iowa, at the crossing
of Main Street, and the sum of \$ 850.00 in hand paid, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, grantors sell and convey unto
Grantee;

A strip of land two hundred and ninety (290) feet in
width situated between Main and Seventh Streets, in
Burnham's Addition to Emmetsburg, Iowa, and off the
East side of Blocks Nos. Nine and Ten (9 & 10) and the
West side of Blocks Nos. Fifteen and Sixteen (15 & 16)
according to the Plat of said Addition, said strip to
include Pleasant Street between said Blocks as a part
thereof, and to be taken equal width on each side of the
center line of its track.
