The South Ninety-two (92) feet of a tract of land in the fractional Southwest one-quarter of the Northwest one-quarter (frl SW ¼ NW ¼) of Section Thirty-one (31), Township Ninety-six (96) North, Range Thirty-two (32) West of the 5th P.M., Palo Alto County, Iowa, described in the Palo Alto County Office of Records, Book 60, Page 52, and more particularly described in attached Exhibit "A". 


EXHIBIT A

A part of the fractional Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (Frt'l SW 1/4 NW 1/4) of Section Thirty-one (31), Township Ninety-six (96) North, Range Thirty-two (32) West of the 5th P.M., Palo Alto County, Iowa, more specifically described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest Corner of said Section 31, at a distance of 10.24 feet west of the centerline of Iowa Highway 4, thence South 0°00' East along the west line of said Section 31 a distance of 1308.8 feet, thence North 89°45.6' East a distance of 100.43 feet to a point on the East right of way line of Iowa Highway 4, which point is the point of beginning of the tract to be conveyed; thence North 89°45.6' East a distance of 552.27 feet, thence South 0°14.8' West a distance of 475.87 feet, thence South 89°45.6' West a distance of 547.75 feet to a point on the East right of way line of Iowa Highway 4, thence North 0°2.3' East along said East right of way line a distance of 175.87 feet, thence Northerly along said East right of way line and along a 16,627.5 foot radius curve, concave westerly and tangent at its beginning to the preceding course, a distance of 300.00 feet to the point of beginning containing 6.000 acres, more or less.
