WITNESSETH: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ninety-five (\$95.00) dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby confessed and acknow ledged, the party of the first part doth hereby REMISE, RELEASE and QUIT CLAIM unto the party of the second part, the following described real estate situated in Saunders County, State of Nebraska, to-wit:

All that part of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter (SE1 SE1) of section ten (10) township twelve (12) north, range nine (9) east of the Sixth ,P. M. lying and being on the southeasterly side of a line drawn one hundred (100) feet distant parallel with and southeasterly from the center line of the west bound main track of the railroad of said Railroad Company as the same was located and constructed during the year 1917, containing seventy-six hundredths (.76) acres, a little more or less.
