as joint tenants with right of survivorship, and not as tenants in common, the following described real property in Saline County, Nebraska :

The North Half $(N_{\frac{1}{2}})$ of the Northwest Quarter $(NW_{\frac{1}{4}})$ in Section Ten (10), Township Five (5) North, Range Four (4), East of the 6th P. M. in Saline County, Nebraska, except a strip of land heretofore deeded to the State of Nebraska for highway purposes which deed is recorded in Book 94 at Page 693 of the deed records of Saline County, Nebraska, and subject to all easements of record.

To have and to hold the above described premises together with all tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the grantees and to their assigns, or to the heirs and assigns of the survivor of them forever.
