 Whereas There has been deposited in the General
 Land Office of the United States a Certificate
 of the Register of the Land Office at Beatrice
 Nebraska whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of
 Congress approved 20th May 1861, and the acts supplemental
 thereto the claim of Alfred Hobbs has been duly consummated in
 conformity to Law for the South half of the South East quarter of
 section Twenty four and the North half of the North East
 quarter of section Twenty five in Township five North of Range
 Four East in the District of Lands subject to sale at Beatrice
 Nebraska containing One hundred and Sixty acres
 according to the Official plat of the survey of the said Land
 returned to the General Land Office by the surveyor General
 John Brown Go that therefore granted by the United States unto
 the said Alfred Hobbs the tract of Land above described
 To have and to hold the said tract of Land with the appurtenances
 thereof unto the said Alfred Hobbs and to his heirs and assigns forever
 In Testimony Whereof I, Ulysses S Grant President of the United
 States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent
 and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed
 Given under my hand at the City of Washington the fifth day of
 November in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight
 hundred and Seventy four and of the Independence of the
 United States the Ninety sixth
