Whereas, there has been depos-
ited in the General Land office of the United
States a Certificate of the Register of the Land office at Beatrice Nebraska
where by it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress, approved 20th
May 1862, to issue Homesteads to actual Settlers on the Public Domain
and the acts supplemental, thereto, the claim of William C. Robertson,
has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for
the North half of the North West, quarter, of Section Ten in Township
Five North of Range four, east, in the District of Lands, subject to
sale, at Beatrice Nebraska containing eighty acres, according to the
official plat of the survey of the said Land returned to the General
Land office by the Surveyor General. Now, Know Ye that there is therefore
granted by the United States unto the said William C. Robertson the tract
of Land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of Land with
the appurtenances, thereof, unto the the said William C. Robertson,
and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof I Ulysses
S. Grant, President of the United States of America, have caused these
letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land office to
be hereunto appoin- Given under my hand at the City of Wash-
