

ORDINANCE NO. 225

AN ORDINANCE CREATING STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICTS NOS. 1976-1 AND 1976-2 IN THE VILLAGE OF DEWITT, NEBRASKA, AND ORDERING THE CONSTRUCTION OF STREET IMPROVEMENTS THEREIN AND ORDERING THE PUBLICATION OF THE ORDINANCE IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DEWITT, NEBRASKA, as follows:

Section 1. That there be and hereby are created in the Village of DeWitt, Nebraska, street improvement districts to be known and designated as Street Improvement Districts Nos. 1976-1 and 1976-2 of said Village.

Section 2. That the outer boundaries of Street Improvement District No. 1976-1 includes, in addition to the streets to be improved, all of the following described property, to-wit:

✓Part of the Southeast Quarter (SE1/4) of Section Fourteen (14), in Township Five (5), North, Range Four (4), East of the 6th P.M. in Saline County, Nebraska, described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast Corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE1/4SE1/4) of Section Fourteen (14), in Township Five (5) North, Range Four (4), aforesaid, thence west on the south line of the North Half (N1/2) of said Southeast Quarter (SE1/4), 140 feet; thence north parallel with the East Section Line 150 feet; thence east parallel with the South Line of the North Half (N1/2) of the Southeast Quarter (SE1/4) 140 feet; thence south along the East Section Line 150 feet to the place of beginning,

✓All of Lot Numbered Twenty-One (21) in Golden Acres First Addition to the Village of DeWitt, Saline County, Nebraska,

✓A tract of land described as follows: Commencing at the northwest corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW1/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW1/4) of Section Thirteen (13), Township Five (5), Range Four (4), East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, in Saline County, Nebraska, thence running south on the West Line of said Tract, Three Hundred Forty Feet; thence due east, Three Hundred Eighteen and 90/100 feet; thence north Three Hundred Forty Feet, to the North Line of said Southwest Quarter (SW1/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW1/4), thence west to the point of beginning, EXCEPT, the portion

thereof in the Southwest Corner previously acquired by the State of Nebraska for highway purposes; thence east 125 feet, thence south 150 feet, thence west 125 feet, thence north 150 feet to the place of beginning,

and within which district the following street shall be improved by curb and gutter:

Hawthorne Street from the Burlington Northern Railroad tracks south to the corporate limit line.

Section 3. That the limits, boundaries and improvements to be made in Street Improvement District No. 1976-2 of said Village are defined and established as follows:

Commencing at the northeast corner of Lot 37, Joseph Suiter's Addition to the Village of DeWitt, Nebraska, thence south to the southeast corner of said Lot, thence southeasterly to the northeast corner of Lot 19, Catherine Suiter's Second Addition, thence south along the east line of said Lot and the east lines of Lots 4 and 9, Block 4, of Catherine Suiter's Third Addition to the south line of Third Addition, thence west along the south line of said Third Addition to the southwest corner of Lot 10, Block 5, said Addition, thence north along the west line of Lots 10 and 5, said Block extended, to the south line of the East-West Alley located immediately south of Madden Avenue, thence northeasterly to the southwest corner of Lot 103, Joseph Suiter's Addition, thence north along the west line of said Lot to the south line of Madden Avenue, thence east along said line to the point of beginning,

and within which district the following street shall be improved by curb and gutter:

The south line of Madden Avenue to the south line of Catherine Suiter's Third Addition.

Section 4. Said streets shall be improved and said improvements shall be made in accordance with the plans, specifications and estimates prepared by the special engineer employed by the Village and to be approved by the Chairman and Board of Trustees.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.

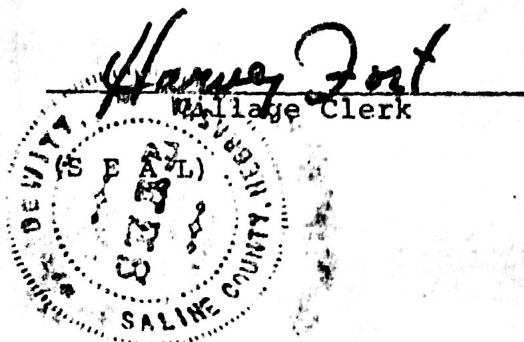
