The United States of America, To All to whom these presents shall come Greeting: Whereas, There has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Beatrice Nebraska, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved^{2d} May 1862, "To Secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Isaac W Taylor has been established^{as} duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the West half of the North West quarter of Section eighteen in Township six, North of Range Three East in the District of Lands subject to sale, at Beatrice Nebraska, containing seventy nine acres and forty one hundredths of an acre according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General I now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said

Isaac W Taylor the tract of Land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Isaac W Taylor and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I, Rutherford B Hayes, President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the sixteenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy eight and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and second.
