Ordinance No. 91

AN ORDINANCE VACATING 15 FEET ON THE SOUTHEAST SIDE OF "H" STREETS SOUTHWESTERLY FROM 5TH STREET TO THE VILLAGE LIMITS AND 15 FEET ON THE NORTHWESTERLY SIDE OF "H" STREET FROM 5TH STREET TO THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a petition representing owners of 100% of the property abutting on "H" Street southwesterly from 5th Street to the village limits has been filed with the Village of Millard, and

WHEREAS, said property owners have in and by said petition waived any and all damages that may be occasioned by the vacating of said property above described;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF MILLARD, DOUGLAS COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. The Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of Millard, Douglas County, Nebraska, hereby find that it is to the best interest of the Village to vacate a part of "H" Street southwesterly from 5th Street to the village limits.

Section 2. The Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of Millard hereby find that in vacating a part of "H" Street as hereinbefore defined will not injure any of the abutting property owners or any of the citizens of the Village.

Section 3. That the southeasterly 15 feet of "H" street from 5th Street to the village limits and that the northeasterly 15 feet of "H" Street from 5th Street to the village limits is hereby vacated, said 15 feet on either side of the road shall run in a parallel line to the present street line and title to said property shall revert to the owners of the adjacent real estate on either side of said "H" Street. Said property is all located in Section 1, Township 14, North, Range 11, East of the 6th P.M. Douglas county, Nebraska.

The vacating of the property herein described and the reversion thereof shall be subject to the condition and limitation that there is reserved to the Village of Millard the right to maintain, operate, repair and renew sewers now existing therein and in the future to construct, maintain, repair and renew additional or other sewers; and also the right of the Village of Millard or any public utility to construct, maintain, repair and renew and operate now existing or hereafter installed water mains, pole lines, conduits and other similar services on equipment above, on and below the surface of the ground for the purpose of serving the general public or abutting property; and the right so reserved shall also include such lateral connections or branch lines as may be ordered, desired or permitted by the Village and to enter upon the premises to accomplish the above purpose at any and all

Section 4. This ordinance shall have full force and effect as provided by law.
