State of Nebraska Patent No 168, 169, 171.
Do all to whom these presents shall come greeting;
Whereas Aaron Keyser has filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Nebraska a receipt of the State Treasurer whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Aaron Keyser according to the act of the Legislature of the State of Nebraska entitled

"An Act to provide for the Erection of a Penitentiary, and for the care and custody of State prisoners" approved March 4th 1870. for all those certain tracts or parcels of land situate and being in the County of Lancaster and Saline and State of Nebraska known and described as follows to wit: North half of Section Twenty eight (28) and South East quarter of Section Twenty (20) Township Tlevelor 12. Range Eight (8) East of the Sixth Principal Meridian containing Four hundred and Eighty (480) acres, and South West quarter of Section Eight (8) Township Eight (8) Range Four (4) East of the Sixth Principal Meridian. One hundred and sixty (160) acres, according to the Government Survey, which said tract has been purchased by the said Aaron Keyser. Now know ye that the State of Nebraska in consideration of the sum of Twenty five hundred and sixty eight (2568) dollars and in conforming with the act of the Legislature in such case made and provided, hath given and granted and by these presents doth give and grant unto the said Aaron Keyser his heirs and assigns the said tract or parcel of land above described To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Aaron Keyser his heirs and assigns forever

In Testimony Whereof I William H. James Acting Governor of the State of Nebraska, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Great Seal of the State of Nebraska to be hereunto affixed. Done at Lincoln this 23 day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy one and of the State the fifth.
