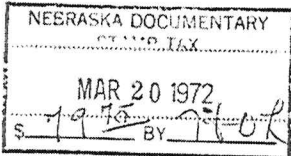
### QUITCLAIM DEED

 and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the grantee and to grantee's heirs and assigns forever.

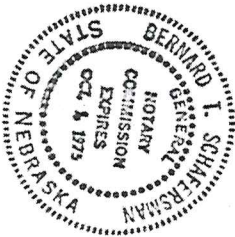
