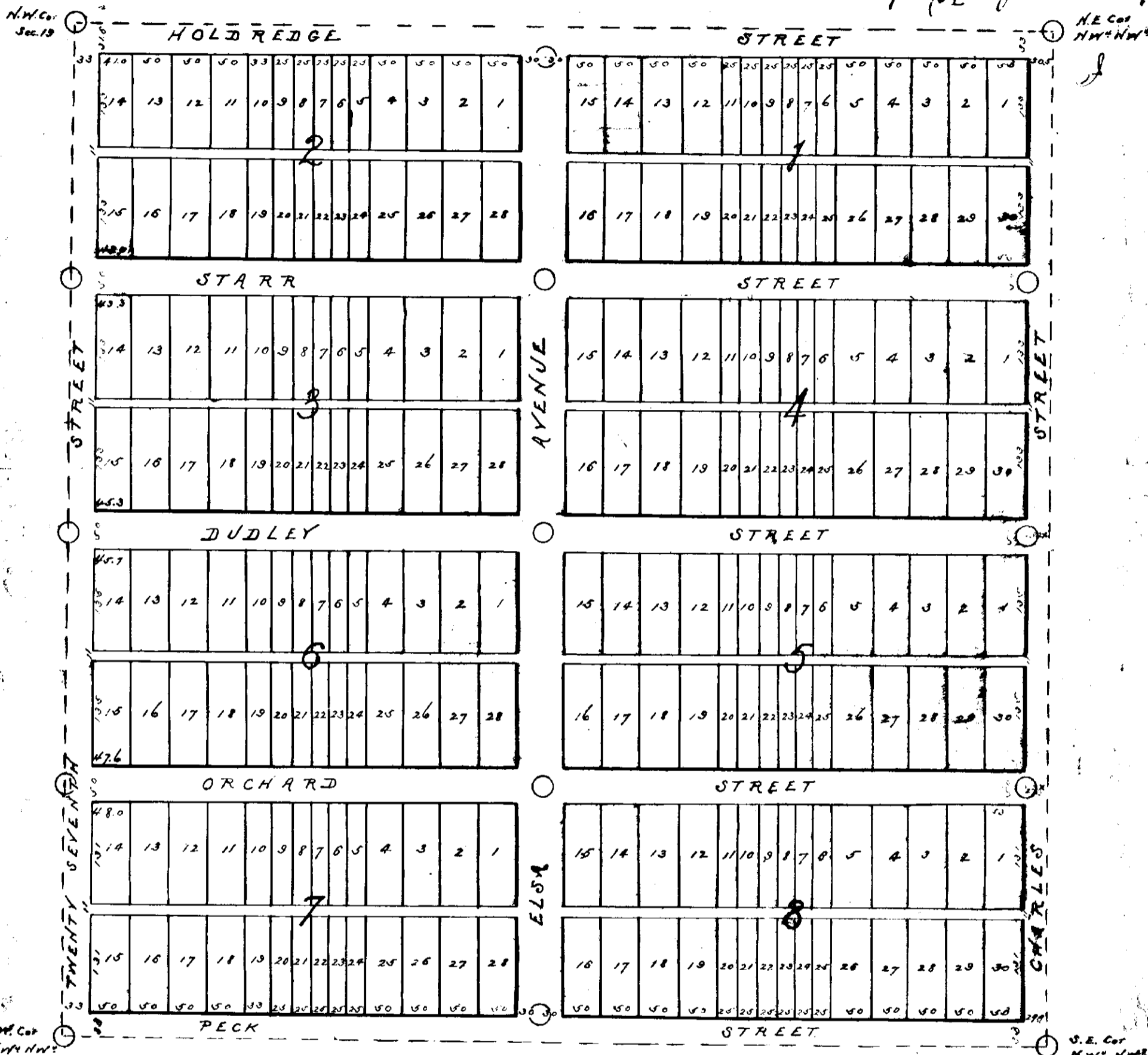


# EAST PARK ADDITION TO LINCOLN NEB.

East Park Addition to Lincoln comprises all of the N.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec 19 Town 10 N. Range 7 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian.  
Peck Street is 30 feet wide  
Orchard, Dudley & Starr Streets are each 50 feet wide  
Holdredge & Charles have dimensions as marked. 27<sup>th</sup> St is 33 ft wide.  
Elsa Avenue is 60 feet wide.  
All alleys are 11 feet wide  
All lots have dimensions as indicated in feet & decimals by red figures on plat.  
All lot lines except those on the East line of 27<sup>th</sup> St are parallel with or at right angles to South line of said N.W. 1/4  
Oak stakes are set at all lot corners on the block lines. Stones are set at points marked thus: .  
Stones were found planted in center of Dudley & Orchard Sts at points marked thus: .
