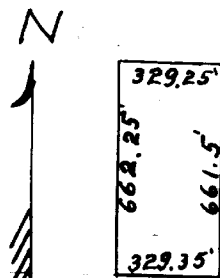

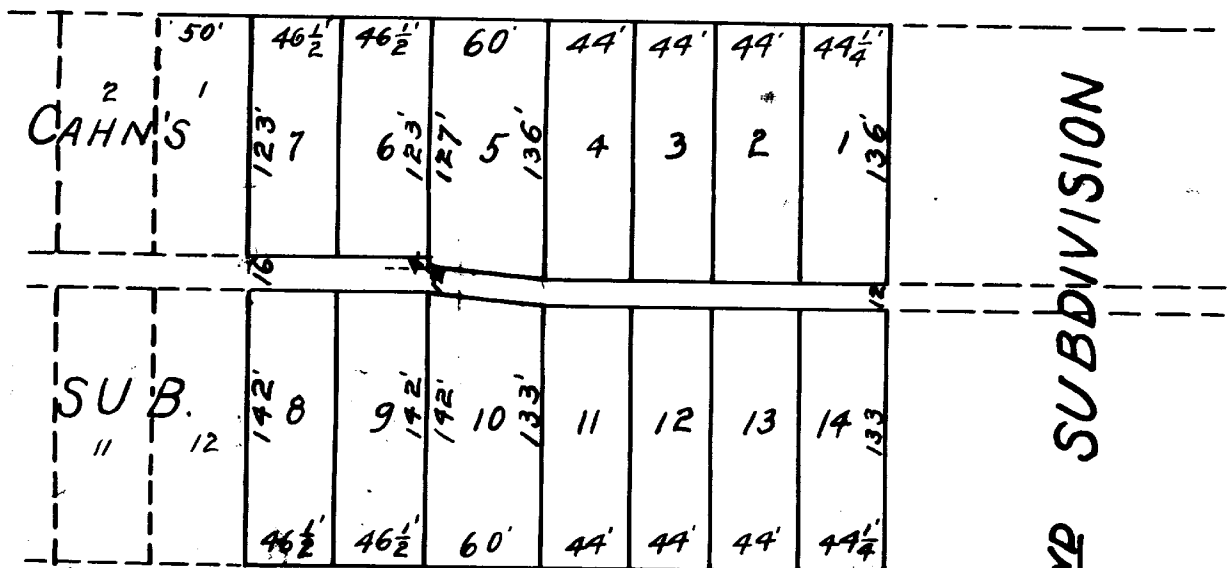

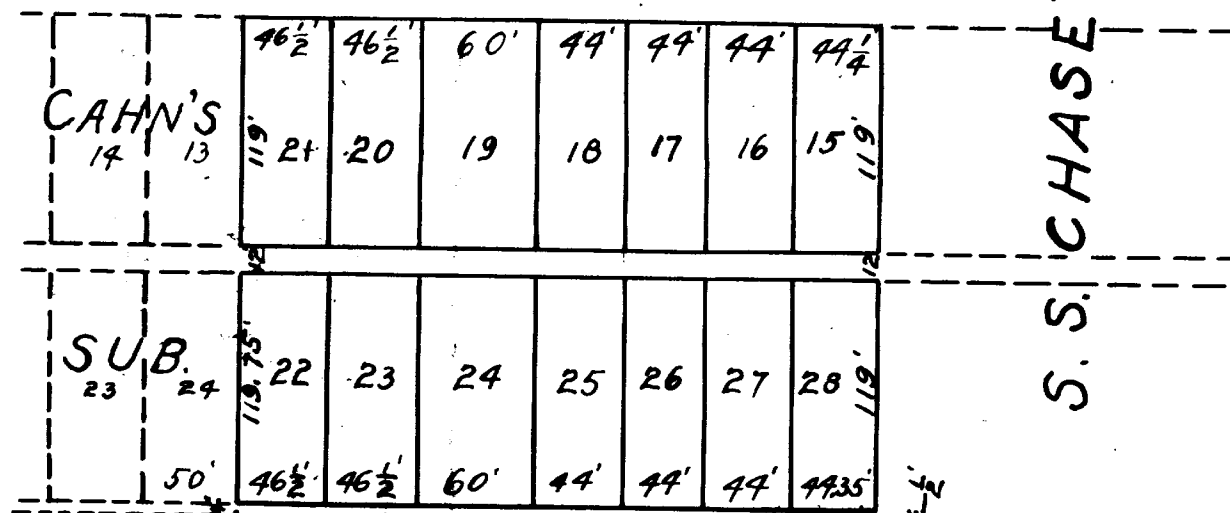


A STREET 119'
