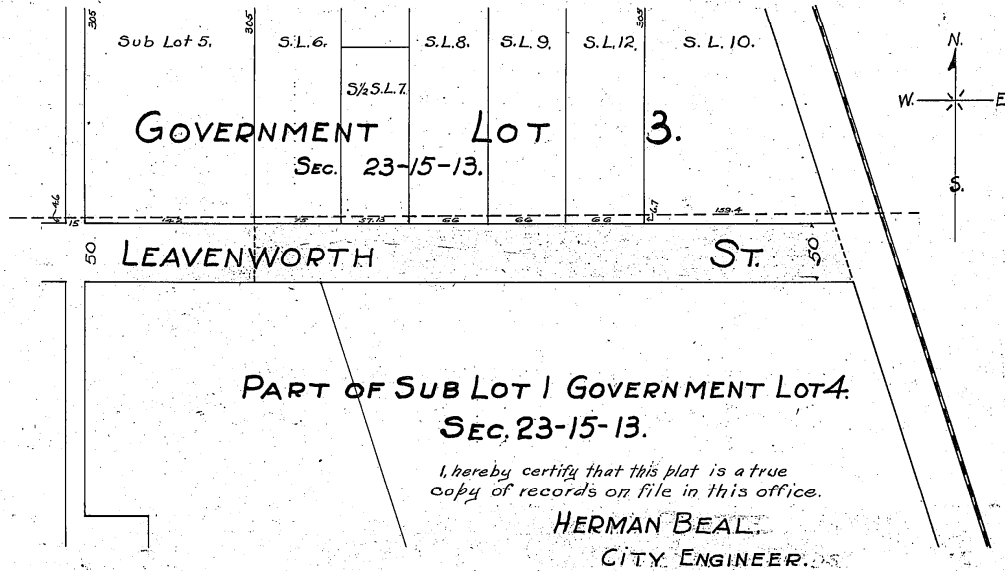

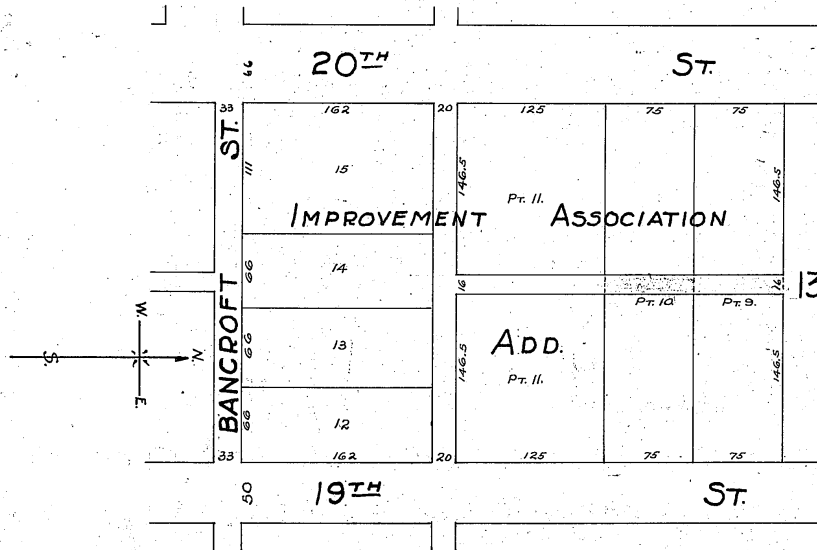

ORDINANCE NO. 11943

An Ordinance vacating Leavenworth Street West from the Missouri River in the City of Omaha.

WHEREAS, A petition representing owners of 100 per cent of the abutting property on Leavenworth Street Westerward from the Missouri River has heretofore been filed with the City of Omaha; and,

WHEREAS, Said property owners have in and by said petition waived any and all damages that may be occasioned by the vacating of said Leavenworth Street,

THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

Section 1. That Leavenworth Street described as follows:

"That portion of Leavenworth Street between the East line extended of Sub Lot 5 of Government Lot 3, Section 23-T.15, North, Range 13, East of the Sixth Principal Meridian: on the West, and the West boundary line of the right of way of the Chicago, Burlington and Quincy Railroad Company on the East.

be, and the same is hereby, vacated; the City of Omaha reserving the right, however, to grant permits for the construction of pole lines with the necessary lateral connections along said part of Leavenworth Street; and also the right to construct sewer, water mains, conduits and any other sub-surface structures which may be found necessary for properly serving abutting property.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force after fifteen days from and after its passage.
