### Warranty Deed

To Peter E. Iler

{ Know all men by these presents, that I Peter E. Iler, (widower) of the City of Omaha County of Omaha Electric Light & Power Co., Douglas and State of Nebraska for and in consideration of Twelve Thousand (\$2,000) dollars in hand paid by Omaha Electric Light & Power Company a corporation do hereby grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said Omaha Electric Light & Power Company the following described real estate situate in the County of Douglas and State of Nebraska to wit.

Beginning at a point Eighty (80) feet South and four hundred eighty seven and  $\frac{1}{100}$  (487.13) feet east of the Southeast corner of fractional Block One hundred eighty one (181) in the City of Omaha as surveyed and lithographed, said point being the northeast corner of a parcel of ground conveyed to New Omaha Thomson Houston Electric Light Company in 1889, and running thence South Three hundred Five (305) feet more or less to the south line of Government lot three (3) in Section twenty three (23) Township Fifteen (15) North of Range Thirteen (13) east, thence east one hundred fifty nine (159) feet more or less to the West line of the Omaha and Southwestern Railroad Company's right of way, thence North twenty (20) degrees and Twenty (20) minutes West more

or less, on the West line of said right of way to the South line of Jones Street, thence West sixty-six (66) feet more or less to the place of beginning, containing seventy two one hundredths (.72) acres and known as sub lot Ten (10) of government lot three (3) in Section Twenty three (23) Township Fifteen (15) North of Range Thirteen (13) east together with all the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging, and all of the estate title, right of homestead claim or demand whatsoever of the said Peter E. Iler, of in and to the same or any part thereof.

To have and to hold the above described premises with the appurtenances unto the said Omaha Electric Light & Power Company and to its successors and assigns (subject to the reservation hereinafter made) forever. And I the said Peter E. Iler for myself and my heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said Omaha Electric Light & Power Company, and with its successors and assigns, that I am lawfully seized of said premises, that they are free from incumbrance, that I have good right and lawful authority to sell the same and that (subject to the reservation aforesaid) I will and my heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the title to the same unto the said Omaha Electric Light & Power Company and its successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever. The grantor herein reserves from the operation of this conveyance the right to grant and convey, to any Railroad Company or Companies within five (5) years from the date hereof a perpetual easement for railroad right of way purposes in so much of the above described premises as is described and bounded as follows to wit:

Commencing at the point of intersection of the West line of the right of way of the Omaha and Southwestern Railroad Company and the South line of Government lot three (3) in Section Twenty three (23) Township Fifteen (15) North of Range Thirteen (13) running thence Northwesterly on the West line of the right of way aforesaid to the south line of Jones Street thence West on said South line of Jones Street, nine (9) feet, thence on a line parallel with the West line of said right of way to a point in the South line of said government lot three (3) Nine (9) feet West from the West line of the right of way aforesaid, thence East Nine (9) feet to the place of beginning. Provided however, such easement shall be limited to the use of said premises for railroad track purposes, and whenever the same shall cease to be so used, the title to said strip shall immediately vest absolutely in the grantee herein named.
