AGREEMENT.

The Byron Reed Company

Nebraska Power Company, et al.

AGREEMENT.

Attached to the lease between The Byron Reed Company, and the Omaha Electric Light & Power Company, dated February 9, 1910, covering certain property at the foot of Jones Street,

East of Railroad Right of Way, Omaha.

It is hereby agreed by and between The Byron Reed Company, party of the first part, Nebraska Power Company (successors to the Omaha Electric Light and Power Company), party of the second part, and Chicago, Burlington and Quincy Railroad Company, party of the third part, as follows, to-wit:

1 - That the Chicago, Burlington & Quincy Railroad Company shall have the same rights to the use of said twenty-five (25) foot strip of land described in the attached lease that it has secured under and by virtue of that certain other lease dated February 9, 1917, and executed by and between the Chicago, Bulington & Quincy Railroad Company and the Omaha Electric Light & Power Company, in and to that part of Government Lot three (3) in 23-15-13, east of the sixth P.M., north of Jones Street in the Cityof Omaha, Lying east of the right of way of said Railroad Company; provided, that no such use shall be made by the Railroad Company of said 25foot strip as shall be inconsistent with the right of the second party to maintain its intake and pipe under the surface of said 25-foot strip as provided in said lease to the second party dated Feb. 9. 1910.

2 - That this right shall be without additional charge, save and except the sum of Two (\$2.00) Dollars this day paid by Chicago, Burlington and Quincy Railroad Company to Nebraska Power Company, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.

3 - The said Chicago, Burlington & Quincy Railroad Company and the said Nebraska Power Company hereby agree that the promises and agreements of each of said parties contained in said lease dated Feb. 9, 1917, with respect to the land therein described, and to the use thereof by said parties, shall extend and be applicable to the said 25-foot strip referred to in said lease of the Byron Reed Company to the Omaha Electric Light & Power Company, dated February 9,1910.
