 and Byron Reed do hereby release and quit-claim unto the
 City of Omaha a certain tract of land bounded and described
 as follows: Beginning at the South-east corner of fractional
 Block one hundred and eighty-one in said City of Omaha and
 running thence South, eighty feet, thence East Six Hundred
 and fifty-three feet more or less to the East boundary line of the
 Omaha + South Western Railroad Company's right of way
 thence North twenty degrees and twenty-one minutes West
 along the said Eastern boundary line of said right of way
 to a point parallel with the North line of Jones Street in
 said City of Omaha and thence West on a line continuous
 with said North line of Jones Street six hundred and nine feet
 more or less to the place of beginning and we hereby dedicate

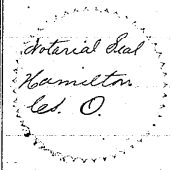
