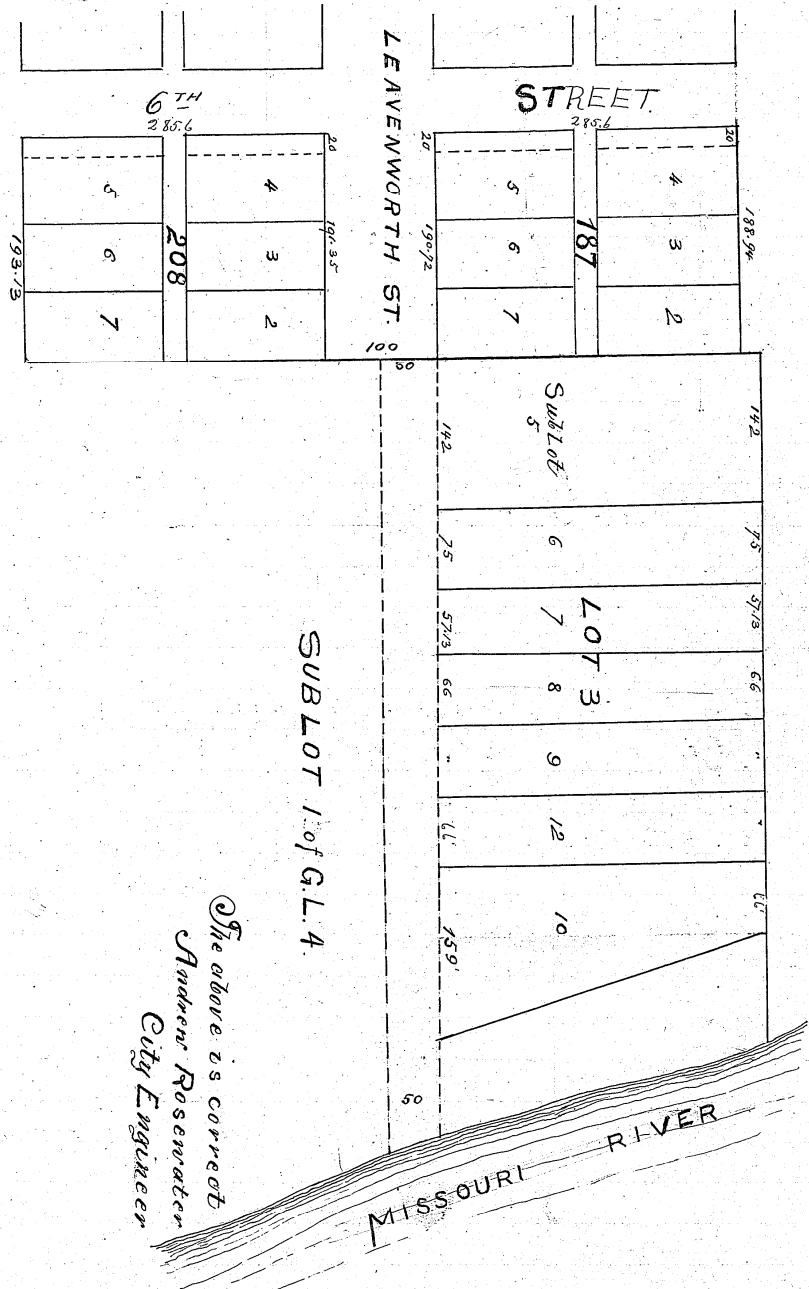

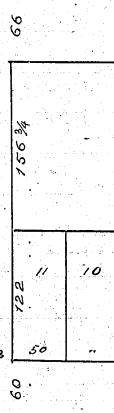
LEAVENWORTH ST

5 Be it ordained by the City
6 Council of the City of Omaha,
7 Section 1

8 Whereas, It has been declared necessary to
9 appropriate certain private property for the
10 purpose of extending Leavenworth Streets from
11 its present eastern terminus to the Missouri
12 River and

13 Whereas, Appraisers have been duly appointed
14 by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council
15 to appraise the value of the property so appropriated
16 and;

17 Whereas, said appraisers after duly qualifying
18 according to law, have made their report of
19 the value of the property appropriated, and said
20 report has been approved by the City Council and
21 the City Treasurer under the authority of the
22 City Council has tendered the amount of the award
23 to the several owners of the property appropriated
24 therefor.

25 Leavenworth Streets from its present eastern
26 terminus to the Missouri River is hereby declar-
27 ed opened for public travel according to the
28 provisions of Ordinance No. 1338.

ORDINANCE No 1338

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF APPROPRIATING CERTAIN PRIVATE PROPERTY AND LANDS FOR THE USE OF THE CITY OF OMAHA, for the purpose of extending

Leavenworth Street from its present eastern terminus to the Missouri River.

and providing for the appointment of three disinterested free-holders of said City, to assess the damages to the owners, respectively, of the property taken by such appropriation.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Omaha:

SECTION 1. That it is necessary, and it is hereby declared necessary, to appropriate certain private property and land for the use of the City of Omaha for the purpose of

extending Leavenworth Street from its present eastern terminus to the Missouri River

said property and land necessary for such purpose being situated in said City of Omaha, and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the south east corner of lot 7 Blk 187 in the City of Omaha, thence south 50 feet, thence east to the Missouri River thence northwly along said river to a point directly east of the north line of Leavenworth Street extended, thence west to the point of beginning.
