

Child vs O'Quinn S.P.R. 6 V

To the undesignated disinterested freeholders and commissioners appointed by the Probate Judge of Douglas County to appraise the damage accruing to E.P. Child by reason of the appropriation of that part of the following described real estate taken for right of way by the Omaha and South-Western Railroad Company, situated in Douglas County Nebraska as shown on the plat and profile of said Road filed and attached to this award to wit:
