

Curtis to Union P. R. Co.

Know all men by these presents that Samuel S. Curtis, in consideration of one dollar in hand paid, do hereby promise, release and forever quit claim unto the Union Pacific Rail Road Company, all my right title, interest and Estate, in and to the following described property situated in the County of Douglas, in the State of Nebraska to wit:

Lot Three (3) in Block Thirty four (34) Lot Five (5) in Block Sixty three (63) Lot one (1) Block Sixty eight (68) Lots Two (2) Four (4) and Five (5) in Block ninety seven (97) Lots Three (3) and Four (4) in Block one hundred and twenty eight (128) Lot Five (5) Block one hundred and fifty seven (157) and all that portion of lots Three (3) and Six (6) in Block one hundred and ninety two (192) lying within fifty feet of the Rail Road Track, and being one fourth (1/4) of the first named lot, and one third (1/3) of the last named lot.
