And I the said Emilie Greb do hereby waive all my right and title to do with in and to the said premises and every part thereof. In testimony whereof we have herewith set our hands this 24th day of February A.D. 1866.

Know all men by these presents, that the City of Omaha, in the County of Douglas and Territory of Nebraska by Loren Miller Mayor for the consideration of One Dollar in hand paid by the "Union Pacific Railroad Company" a Corporation organized under the laws of the United States, the Receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant and convey unto the said Railroad Company and to their successors and assigns forever, the following piece or parcel

of land, situate in the County of Douglas and Territory of Nebraska to wit: Lot One in Block Sixty six. Lots Three and four in Block Sixty seven. Lot One in Block Ninety four. Lot One in Block One Hundred and fifty six. Lot Three in Block One Hundred and fifty seven. Lot Five in Block Three Hundred and seven. Lot Six in Block Three and thirteen. Lot Seven in Block Three Hundred and twenty two. Lot two in Block Three Hundred and twenty seven. Lots five and six in Block Three Hundred and twenty eight. Lot Seven in Block Three Hundred and twenty eight and Lot three in Block Three Hundred and thirty three, all in the City of Omaha, to have and to hold the same unto the said Railroad Company and to their Successors and assigns forever. Provided, That in case said Railroad Company do not construct their Road through said tract, or shall, after construction, permanently abandon the route through said tract of land or the occupancy thereof then the same shall revert to and become revivified in the said grantor or his heirs or assigns. This conveyance is made pursuant to a resolution of the City Council of said City of Omaha, passed on 15th day of January 1864 - signed this third day of March AD One thousand Eight hundred and Sixty six.
