Supp. Nebraska 1939, this conveyance is made upon the condition that the Consumers Public Power District shall comply with the provisions of said bill, and shall annually pay out of its revenue, to the state of Nebraska, county, city, village and school district in which the properties herein conveyed are located, in lieu of taxes, a sum equal to the amount which the state, counties, cities, villages and school districts received from taxation, including occupation taxes, from such property or from the company during the year immediately preceding the purchase of acquisition of such property by the District, so long as such act shall be in full force and effect.
