RESOLVED ,

WHEREAS, the American Smelting and Refining Company is desirous of having a dumping site for the dumping of slag and other refuse from its smelting and refining operations in Omaha; and

WHEREAS, such slag and other refuse is unexcelled for filling purposes, and there is on the Missouri River adjacent to and abutting on property owned by the City certain locations which, if filled with such slag or other refuse, would be to the benefit of the City;

RESOLVED, that an easement be and hereby is granted to American Smelting and Refining Company, and to its successors or assigns, giving it the perpetual, exclusive and absolute right and authority to dump slag and other smelter refuse along the banks of the Missouri River, adjacent to and abutting upon any property owned by the City and located in Government Lot 3, in Section 14, Township 15, Range 13, and all accretions thereto, in Douglas County, Nebraska, beginning at a point approximately 265 feet north of the south boundary of said Government Lot 3, together with a right-of-way across the City's properties in Government Lots 3 and 4 in such section, township and range, for the purpose of hauling such slag or other smelter refuse.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor be and hereby is authorized and directed to sign, for and on behalf of the City, and the City Clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to attest, for and on behalf of the City, an agreement setting forth the terms of the easement herein granted, in such words as by their execution they may approve, and thereupon to deliver the same to American Smelting and Refining Company.
