- BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

  Section 1. That the East-West Alleys between Douglas Street
  and Farnam Street from 11th Street to 14th Street located in

  Northeast quarter (%), Section 22-15-13

be, and hereby is, vacated; the vacating of the property herein described, and the reversion thereof, pursuant to applicable law, shall be subject to the conditions and limitation that there is reserved to the City of Omaha the right to maintain, operate, repair and renew sewers now existing therein and in the future to construct,

maintain, repair and renew additional or other sewers, also the right to authorize the Metropolitan Utilities District of the City of Omaha or any other public utility to construct, maintain, repair or renew and operate now existing or hereafter installed water mains, pole lines, conduits and other similar services or equipment above, on and below the surface of the ground for the purpose of serving the general public or abutting property; and the right so reserved shall also include such lateral connection or branch lines as may be ordered, desired or permitted by the City and to enter upon the premises to accomplish the above purpose at any and all times.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force fifteen (15) days from and after the date of its passage.
