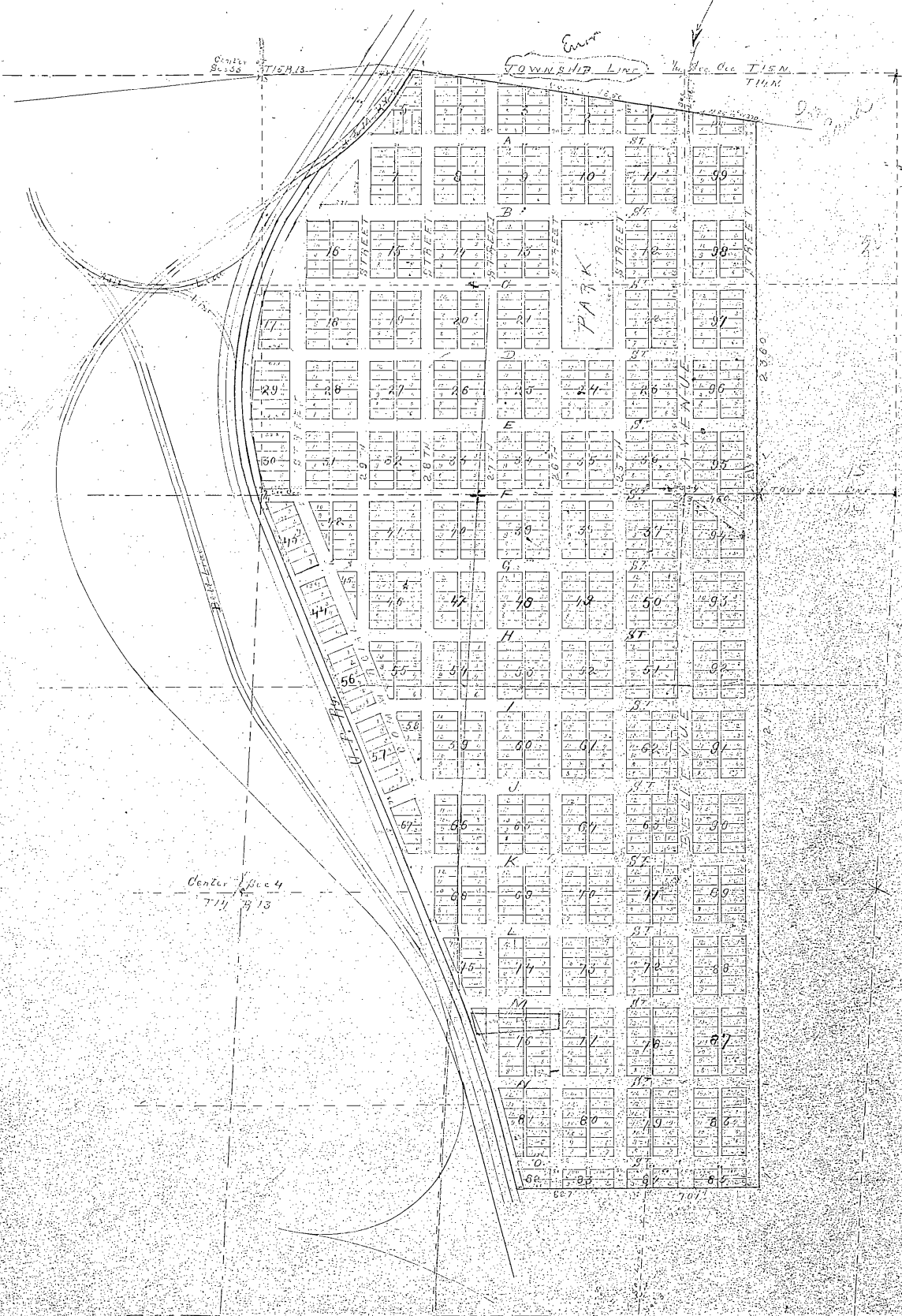

I Certify that I have surveyed and staked off and marked the Lots, Streets, Alleys and Public Grounds of South Omaha as shown on the accompanying map. The same being situated upon the following described lands to-wit: Beginning on the Township line between Township No 1 & 2, R. 13, at a point 450 ft East of the S. E. Corner of Sec 33 of T. 15, R. 13, E. of the 6th P.M. thence North parallel to the said Township line to the N. E. Corner of said sec 33, distance 2500 feet to the North boundary of said sec 33, thence as the Survey shows N 80° 15' W 370 ft then as said boundary line N 80° 15' W along said Township line 1550 ft to the east boundary of the Town of South Omaha, thence 50 feet north along said boundary of said Township line 50 feet North of said Township line 50 feet West of east line Township above to the North boundary of said 1/4 P.M. of way to the North line of land granted above by the State in sec 3 of T. 15, R. 13. Subject to the terms of a Conveyance by the Proprietor to the Union Pacific Ry Co bearing date Jan 11, 1854, recorded at Long 54 of said at page 540. thence East parallel to the said Township line 577 feet to a point in the line between sec 3 and 4 of T. 15 and Range as East about more or less 1347 feet South of the N. E. Cor. between said sec 3 and 4, then south along 110 feet East of the S. E. Corner of Lot 3, Block 1st, thence East in said Corner 781 ft to E line of 23rd St, thence North parallel to the line between sec 3 and 4 as above 421 feet to place of beginning - then 140 acres in sec 33 and 25 acres in sec 34 of T. 15, R. 13 and 165 acres in sec 4 and 50 acres in sec 3 of T. 15, R. 13 E. Douglas Co. Neb.

Beginning on the Township line between townships
 No. 14th & 15th North at a point 450 ft. East of the S. E. corner
 of section 33 of T. 15. R. 13. E. of the 6th P. M. thence North
 parallel to the line connecting the N. E. and S. E. corner
 of said section 33; distance 2360 feet to the north
 boundary of what was known as the Leeland thence
 North 80³/₄° W. 370 feet along the said boundary line thence
 N. 80³/₄° W. along said boundary line 1850 ft. to the East
 boundary of the R. M. Ry. R. of way being 50 ft. at rt.
 angle from center of location; and thence southerly
 along said line of R. of way to the N. P. R. of way thence
 southerly along the East boundary of said N. P. R. of way
 to the South line of land formerly owned by Fred Duxel
 in Sec. 4. T. 14. R. 13. Subject to the terms of a Conveyance
 by the Proprietors to the Union Pacific Ry. Co. bearing
 date July 14. 1884. Recorded in Book 54 of Deeds at page
 590. thence East parallel to the first mentioned town-
 ship line 827 ft. to a point in the line between Sec. 3
 and 4 of town and Range as last above mentioned;
 1847 ft. South of the 14 sec. Corner between said sections
 3 and 4 said point being 119 feet East of the S. E. corner
 of lot 3 block 84. thence East in last course 701 feet to
 E. line of 23rd street thence North parallel to the line
 between Secs 33 and 34 as above 4218 ft. to place of
 beginning being 144 acres in 33, and 25 acres in sec.
 34. of T. 15 N. and 165 acres in sec. 4, and 55 acres
 in sec. 3 of T. 14 N. all of Range 13 E. Douglas County
 Nebraska. That the above subdivision of the said
 lands as appears on this plat is made, certified and
 recorded in the clerk's office of Douglas County with
 the free consent and in accordance with the desire
 of the undersigned owners and proprietors of said lands

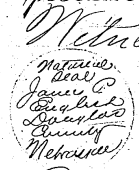
