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

SPECIAL PERMIT NO. 1821

WHEREAS, Regal Building Systems, Inc. has submitted an application designated as Special Permit No. 1821 for authority to construct an early childhood care facility on property located at North 24th and Dodge Streets, and legally described to wit:

> A tract of land located in the North Half of Section 12, Township 10 North, Range 6 East of the 6th P.M., Lancaster County, Nebraska and more particularly described as follows:

Referring to the southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 12; thence in a northerly direction, along the east line of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 12, on an assumed bearing of north 00 degrees 04 minutes 52 seconds west, for a distance of 811.04 feet to the centerline of Old Dairy Road; thence along said centerline of Old Dairy Road, north 88 degrees 42 minutes 53 seconds west, for a distance of 471.04 feet; thence north 01 degrees 17 minutes 07 seconds east, for a distance of 33.00 feet; thence on a curve to the right with a central angle of 42 degrees 36 minutes 55 seconds, a radius of 117.00 feet, a chord bearing of north 67 degrees 52 minutes 58 seconds west, a chord length of 85.03 feet, and an arc distance of 87.02 feet; thence south 43 degrees 25 minutes 34 seconds west, for a distance of 66.00 feet; thence north 88 degrees 45 minutes 16 seconds west, for a distance of 723.37 feet; thence north 00 degrees 02 minutes 31 seconds west, for a distance of 495.97 feet; thence north 00 degrees 14 minutes 33 seconds west, for a distance of 233.92 feet; thence north 00 degrees 01 minutes 15 seconds west, for a distance of 185.74 feet to the point of beginning; thence north 00 degrees 01 minutes 15 seconds west, for a distance of 182.02 feet; thence north 89 degrees 59 minutes 39 seconds east, for a distance of 238.85 feet; thence south 00 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds west, for a distance of 182.04 feet; thence south 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds west, for a distance of 238.78 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.998 acres, more or less;



1	WHEREAS, the real property adjacent to the area included within the site
2	plan for this early childhood care facility will not be adversely affected; and
3	WHEREAS, said site plan together with the terms and conditions hereinafter
4	set forth are consistent with the intent and purpose of Title 27 of the Lincoln Municipal
5	Code to promote the public health, safety, and general welfare.
6	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of
7	Lincoln, Nebraska:
8	That the application of Regal Building Systems, Inc., hereinafter referred to
9	as "Permittee", to construct an early childhood care facility on the property legally
10	described above, be and the same is hereby granted under the provisions of Section
11	27.63.070 of the Lincoln Municipal Code upon condition that construction and operation
12	of said early childhood care facility be in strict compliance with said application, the site
13	plan, and the following additional express terms, conditions, and requirements:
14	1. This permit approves an early childhood care facility with a maximum
15	of 118 children.
16	2. The requirement of Section 27.63.070(c) of the Lincoln Municipal Code
17	that a center with over 30 children be located on an arterial street is hereby waived.
18	3. Before receiving building permits:
19	a. The Permittee must submit a revised and reproducible final
20	plat of the specific site plan and the entire use permit area.
21	b. As required by design standards, the Permittee must provide
22	an elevation of the facility, for review and approval by the

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Director of Planning, for compatibility of design in relation to

adjacent existing or future residences.

- 4. Before occupying any of this development all development and construction shall be completed in conformance to the approve plans.
- 5. All privately-owned improvements shall be permanently maintained by the Permittee or an appropriately established property owners association approved by the City Attorney.
- 6. The site plan approved by this permit shall be the basis for all interpretations of setbacks, yards, locations of buildings, location of parking and circulation elements, and similar matters.
- 7. The terms, conditions, and requirements of this resolution shall be binding and obligatory upon the Permittee, its successors, and assigns. The building official shall report violations to the City Council which may revoke the special permit or take such other action as may be necessary to gain compliance.
- 8. The Permittee shall sign and return the City's letter of acceptance to the City Clerk within 30 days following approval of the special permit, provided, however, said 30-day period may be extended up to six months by administrative amendment. The City Clerk shall file a copy of the resolution approving the special permit and the letter of acceptance with the Register of Deeds, filing fees therefor to be paid in advance by the Permittee.
