of the County of Douglas, State of Nebraska, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand and 00/100 (\$2,000.00) Dollars to have and to hereby grant, keep, hold and confirm unto THE STATE OF NEBRASKA the following described real estate situated in Douglas County, State of Nebraska, to-wit:

A tract of land located in the northern part of part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 20, Township 15 North, Range 12 East of the 6th P.M., Douglas County, Nebraska, described as follows:

And we have full right and lawful authority to sell the same; and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the title to said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whatsoever.


