

between Warren L. Jacobs & Jennie L. Jacobs
Sanitary and Improvement District No. 195 of Douglas County, Nebraska, and the City of Omaha, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as "Grantee(s)";
WITNESSETH: That said Grantor(s) in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration, to Grantor(s) in hand paid by said Grantee(s) the receipt where-of is hereby acknowledged; does or do hereby grant, sell, convey and confirm unto said Grantee(s), their successors and assigns forever, a permanent sewer and drainage easement for the right to use, construct, build, lay, maintain, repair and construct sanitary or storm sewer pipe, or both, for the passage of sewer water and sewage together with all appurtenances, wires, lines, poles, structures, and other applicable equipment pertaining to any sewer, or drainage facility, in, through, over and under the parcel of land more particularly described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto which
No buildings, improvements, or structures, shall be placed in, on, over, or across said permanent easement by the undersigned, his or their successors and assigns without express approval of Grantee(s), their successors and assigns. Any trees, grass, and shrubbery placed on said permanent easement shall be maintained by Grantor(s), his, or their heirs, successors and assigns.
Grantee(s) shall cause any trench made on aforesaid realty to be properly refilled, and shall cause the area disturbed by said easement to be seeded
upon the completion of construction and shall cause the premises to be left in a neat and orderly condition. The easement is also for the benefit of any contractor, agent, employee and representative of Grantee(s) and in any of said construction and work.
Said Grantor(s) for himself or themselves and his or their heirs, executors and administrators does or do confirm with the said Grantee(s) and their assigns, that he or they, the Grantor(s), is or are well seized in fee of the above described property and that he or they has or have the right to grant and convey this easement in the manner and form aforesaid, and that he or they will, and his or their heirs, executors and administrators, shall warrant and defend this easement unto gaid Grantee(s), their successors and assigns against lawful claims and demands of all persons. This easement runs with the land.
The consideration recited includes damages for change of grade, if any, and any and all claims for damage arising from change of grade or grading are hereby waived.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

A 10' wide PERMANENT sewer and drainage essement in the NW 1/4 of Section 21, T 15 N. R 12 E of the 6th P.M., Douglas County, Nebrusko, described as follows: Beginning at a point which is 512.78 feet South and 690.18 feet East from the Northwest corner of said NW 1/4 of Section 21, said point being on the Southwesterly curved R.G.W. line of Interstate #680; thence S 49° 05' 37" W, 10.0 feet; thence on a curve to the right (radius being 1005.92 feet, chord bearing B 37° 48' 08" E), an arc distance of 108.91 feet; thence S 34° 42' 09" E, 256.15 feet; thence N 55° 17' 51" E, 10.0 feet to a point on the Southwesterly R.O.W. line of Interstate #680; thence R 34° 42' 99" W on the said Interstate R.O.W. line, 256.15 feet to a point of curve; thence on a curve to the left on said Interstate R.O.W. line (radius being 1615.32 feet; chord bearing N 37° 48' 08" M), an arc distance of 118.9 feet to the point of beginning. (The West Line of the NW 1/4 of said Section 21 secured S 0° 30° 00" W in direction.)

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
