An Ordinance creating Ornamental Lighting District No. 263, defining the limits thereof, designating the improvements to be made therein, designating the property to be benefited, providing for the payment of the cost thereof, and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska: Section 1. That Ornamental Lighting District No. 263 he and

Section 1. That Ornamental Lighting District No. 263 be and the same is hereby created; that said-ornamental lighting district is created for the purpose of acquiring and installing ornamental lights, including poles, fixtures, wiring, underground conduits, and all necessary equipment and accessories, in or along the following described street, streets, public grounds, public way or ways, within the City of Lincoln, to-wit: Southwest 25th Street from West 'O' Street to West 'L' Street, Southwest 27th Street from West '0' Street to 180 feet south of West 'L' Street, West 'L' Street from Southwest 27th Street to the east line of Western State Industrial Tract, and all of West 'M' Court located in Western State Industrial Tract 1st Addition, that said ornamental lighting district shall include the following described real estate benefited, to-wit: all of Western State Industrial Tract; Lots 1, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16, Block 1, Western State Industrial Tract 1st Addition; Lots 3 through 8, Block 1 including all that portion of the east-west alley vacated by Ordinance No. 10443 abutting said Lots 3 through 8, Block 1, Lots 3 through 8, Block 2, and Lots 13 through 18, Block 5, Burlington Heights; all that portion of Southwest 27th Street vacated by Ordinance No. 12596 abutting Lot 7, Block 3, Western State Industrial Tract; Lot 77, the east 150 feet of Lots 67, 78 and 93, and the east 150 feet of the north 225.03 feet of Lot 94, all Irregular Tracts located in the Northeast Quarter of Section 29, Township 10 North, Range 6 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in the City of Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska.

The cost of acquiring and installing said ornamental lights, including poles, fixtures, wiring, underground conduits, and all necessary equipment and accessories, and all other expenses incidental thereto, shall be assessed proportionately to the property specially benefited in

said district, not exceeding the special benefits accruing on account thereof.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.
