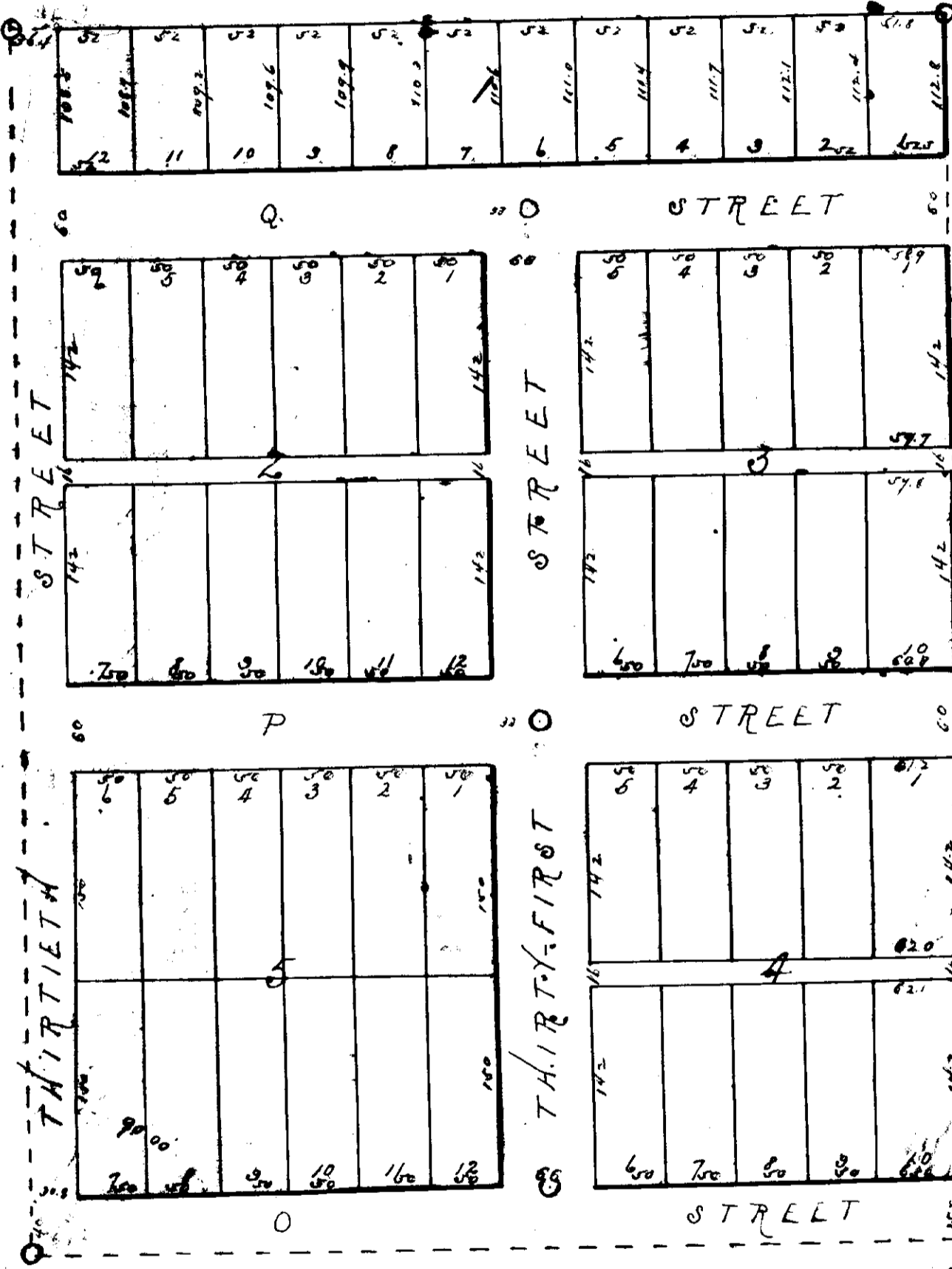

SW 1/4 of Section No 19 T 10 N R 7 E  
of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. Lancaster Co. Neb.  
and running thence North 52  
rods 1/8 feet, thence East 40  
rods, thence South 52 rods 1/8  
feet, thence West 40 rods to place  
of beginning.

All lots have dimensions as mark-  
ed in feet by decimals in red fig-  
ures on the plat.

O Street has dimensions as marked.  
P & Q streets are each 60 feet wide.
