ORDINANCE NO.124

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING VACATED THE FOLLOWING STREETS AND ALLEYS IN THE FIRST ADDITION TO THE VILLAGE OF RALSTON, DOUGLAS COUNTY, NEBRASKA, TO-WIT:

Ralston Avenue from Seventy-second Street to the West line of Seventy-fifth Street:
Thayer Avenue from Seventy-second Street to Seventy-fourth Street;
Sarpy Avenue from Seventy-second Street to Seventy-seventh Street;
Crounse Avenue from Seventy second-Street to Seventy-fifth Avenue;

Fontenelle Avenue from Seventy-second Street to the County Road on the North and South half-sectionline of Section Eleven (11), Township Fourteen (14), Range (12);

Seventy-fourth Street from Ralston Avenue to the South line of the said First

Addition to Ralston;

Seventy-fifth Street from Ralston Avenue to Sarpy Avenue;

Seventy-fifth Avenue from Ralston Avenue to the South line of the said First Addition to Ralston;

Sevnety-sixth Street from Ralston Avenue to the South line of the said First Addition to Ralston;

Seventy-sixth Avenue from Ralston Avenue to the South line of the said First addition to Ralston;

Seventy-seventh Street from Ralston Avenue of the South line of the said First Addition to Ralston;

The Following Alleys, to-wit:

Alleys in BlocksSix (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11), Twelve (12), Thirteen (13), Fourteen (14), Fiftheen (15), Sixteen (16), Seventeen (17), Eighteen (18), Ninesteen (19) Twenty (20), Twenty-one (21), Twenty-three (23), Twenty-four (24), Twenty-five (25), Twenty-six (26), all being in the said Frist Addition to the Village of Ralston, Douglas County, Nebraska, and the same being all the Streets and alleys in the said First Addition to the Village of Ralston except the Following: Ralston Avenue from the west line of Seventy-fifth Street to the county Road on the North and South halfsection line of Section Eleven (11), Township Fourteen (14), Range Twelve (12), Seventy-Seventh Street from Ralston Avenue North to the North line of said First Addition to Ralston; and the Street (Serum Street) from Seventy-seventh Street West on the Half-section line of said Section Eleven (11), Township Fourteen (14), Range Twelve (12), to the County Road on the North and South-Half-section line of said Section Eleven (11), Township Fourteen (14), Range Twelve (12), Douglas County, Nebraska.

Whereas, it has been duly declared necessary by Ordenance of the Village of Ralston to vacate certain Streets and Alleys in the First Addition to the Village of Ralston, Douglas County, Nebraska, as set forth in this Ordinance and,

Whereas, Five disinterested householders of said Village of Ralston were duly appionted by the Village Board of said Village to ascertain, determine, assess and appraise the damages sustained by any person or person on account of said vacation, and said appraisers took oath as required by the Ordinance of said Village of Ralston, and made assessment and appraisement and filed the same in writing with the Village Clerk of said Village for confirmation, and said assessment and appraisement has been duly adopted and confirmed by the Chairman and Board of

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Trustees of said Village and all other requirements of law relating to the vacation of the said Streets and alleys have been fully complied with:

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the Chairman and board of Trustees of the Village of Ralston, Douglas County, Nebraska:

SECTION 1.

That the following Streets and alleys in the First Addition to the Village of Ralston, Douglas County, Nebraska, to-wit:

Ralston Avenue from Seventy-second Street to the West line of Seventy-fifth Street;
Thayer Avenue from Seventy-second Street to Seventy-fourth Street;
Sarpy avenue from Seventy-second Street to Seventy-seventh Street;
Crounse Avenue from Seventy-second Street to Seventy-fifth Avenue;

Fontenelle Avenue from Seventy-second Street to the County Road on the North and South half-section line of section Eleven (11), Township Fourteen (14), Range Twelve (12);

Seventy-forth Street from Ralston Avenue to the South Line of the said First

Seventy-forth Street from Ralston Avenue to the South Line of the said First Addition to Ralston;

Seventy-fifth Street from Ralston Avenue to Sarpy Avenue;

Seventy-fifth Avenue from Ralston Avenue to the South line of the said First Addition to Ralston;

Seventy-sixth Street from Ralston Avenue to the South line of the said First Addition to Ralston,

Seventy-sixth Avenue from Ralston Avenue to the South line of the said First Addition to Ralston,

Seventy-seventh Street from Ralston Avenue of the South line of the said First Addition to Ralston;

The Following Alleys to-wit:

Alleys in Blocks Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11),
Twelve (12), Thirteen (13), Fourteen (14), Fifteen (15), Sixteen (16), Seventeen (17), Eighteen
(18), Nineteen (19), Twenty (20), Twenty-one (21), Twenty-three (23), Twenty-four (24),
Twenty-five (25), Twenty-six (26), all being in the First Addition to the Village of Ralston,
Douglas county, Nebraska, and the same being all the Streets and Alleys in the said First Addition
to the Village of Ralston except the following:

Ralston Avenue from the West line of Seventy-fifth Street to the County Road on the North and South half-section line of Section Eleven (11), Township (14), Range (12), Seventy-seventh Street north from Ralston Avenue of the North line of said Frist Addition to Ralston; and the Street (Serum Street) from Sevnety-seventh Street West on the half-section line of section Eleven (11), Township (14), Range (12), to the County Road on the North and South half-section line of said Section (11), Township (14), Range (12), Douglas county, Nebraska within the Village of Ralston, be and they are hereby declared vacated.
