The United States of America, To all to whom these presents shall come greeting
Whereas in pursuance of the Act of Congress approved March 3 1855. entitled
An Act in addition to certain Acts granting bounty land to certain officers and
soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States
there has been deposited in the general land office Warrant No. 84044 for
160 acres in favor of Henry C. Hall Private Company E. 1st Regiment U.S.
Dragoons, California Indian War with evidence that the same has been
duly located upon the South east quarter of Section Thirty five in Township
five North of Range thirteen east. in the District of lands Subject to sale at

Brownville Nebraska, containing One hundred and Sixty acres according to the official Plat of the Survey of the Said land returned to the General Land office by the Surveyor General, the Said Warrant having been assigned by the Said Henry C. Wall to George W. Norton in whose favor the Said tract has been located and by him the one undivided half of the certificate of location assigned to George E. Harding. Now know ye, that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the Said George W. Norton and to George E. Harding as assignee as aforesaid and to their heirs the tract of land above described, To have and to hold the Said tract of land with the appurtenances thereof unto the Said George W. Norton and to George E. Harding as assignee as aforesaid and to their heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I James Buchanan President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent and the Seal of the General Land office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the fifteenth day of September in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and Sixty, and of the Independence of the United States the eighty fifth
