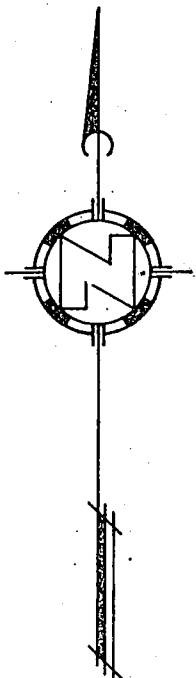


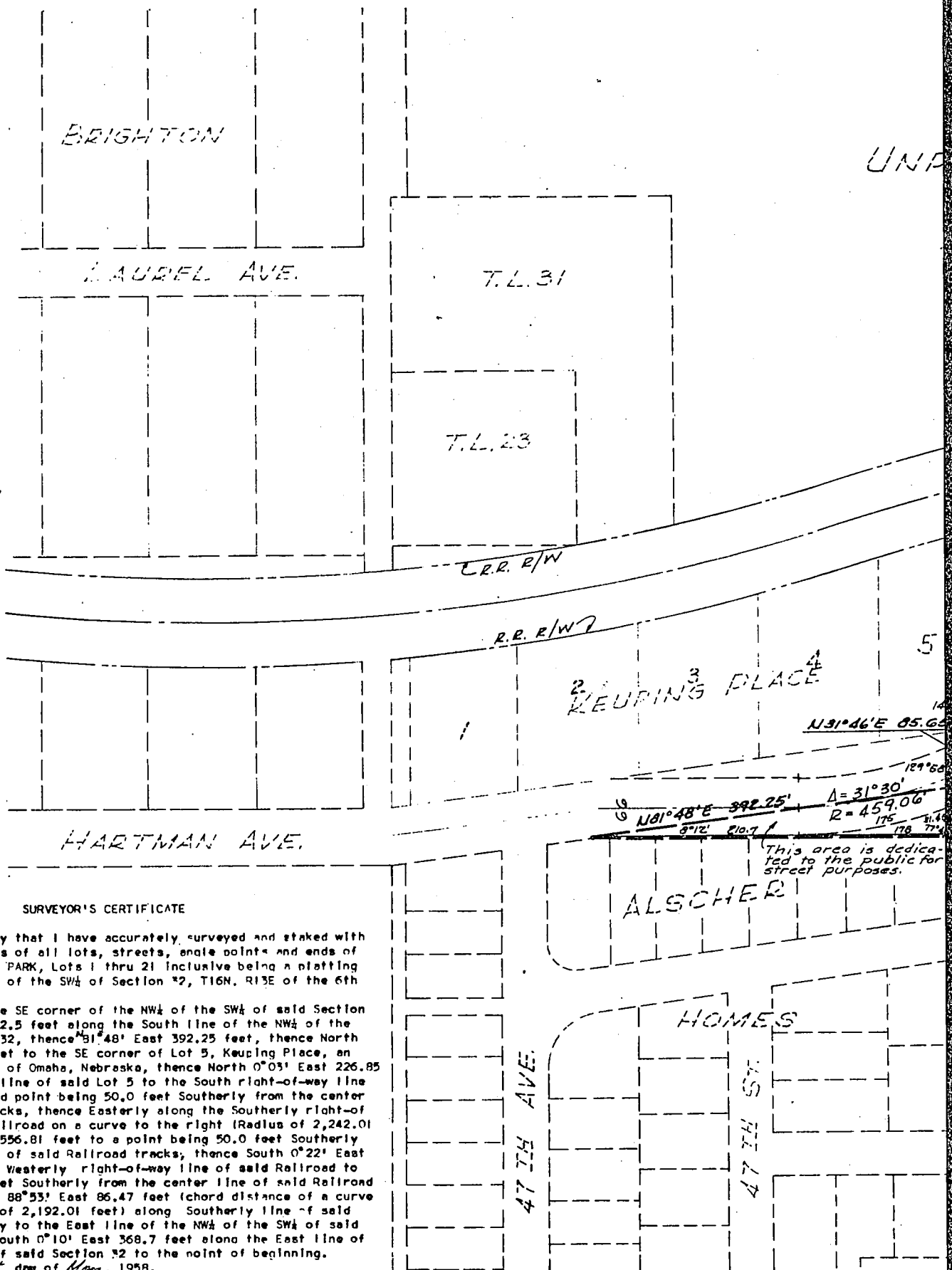
LAUREL

SCALE: 1" = 100'



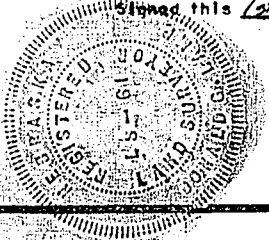
SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I hereby certify that I have accurately surveyed and staked with iron pipe all corners of all lots, streets, angle points and ends of all curves in LAUREL PARK, Lots 1 thru 21 inclusive being a platting of a part of the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 32, T16N, R13E of the 6th PM., to wit:

Beginning at the SE corner of the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said Section 32, thence West 1,072.5 feet along the South line of the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said Section 32, thence N31°48' East 392.25 feet, thence North 31°46' East 85.65 feet to the SE corner of Lot 5, Keuping Place, an addition to the City of Omaha, Nebraska, thence North 0°03' East 226.85 feet along the East line of said Lot 5 to the South right-of-way line of the Railroad, said point being 50.0 feet Southerly from the center line of Railroad tracks, thence Easterly along the Southerly right-of-way line of said Railroad on a curve to the right (Radius of 2,242.01 feet) a distance of 556.81 feet to a point being 50.0 feet Southerly from the center line of said Railroad tracks, thence South 0°22' East 50.0 feet along the Westerly right-of-way line of said Railroad to a point being 100 feet Southerly from the center line of said Railroad tracks, thence South 88°53' East 86.47 feet (chord distance of a curve to the right Radius of 2,192.01 feet) along Southerly line of said Railroad right-of-way to the East line of the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said Section 32, thence South 0°10' East 368.7 feet along the East line of the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said Section 32 to the point of beginning.

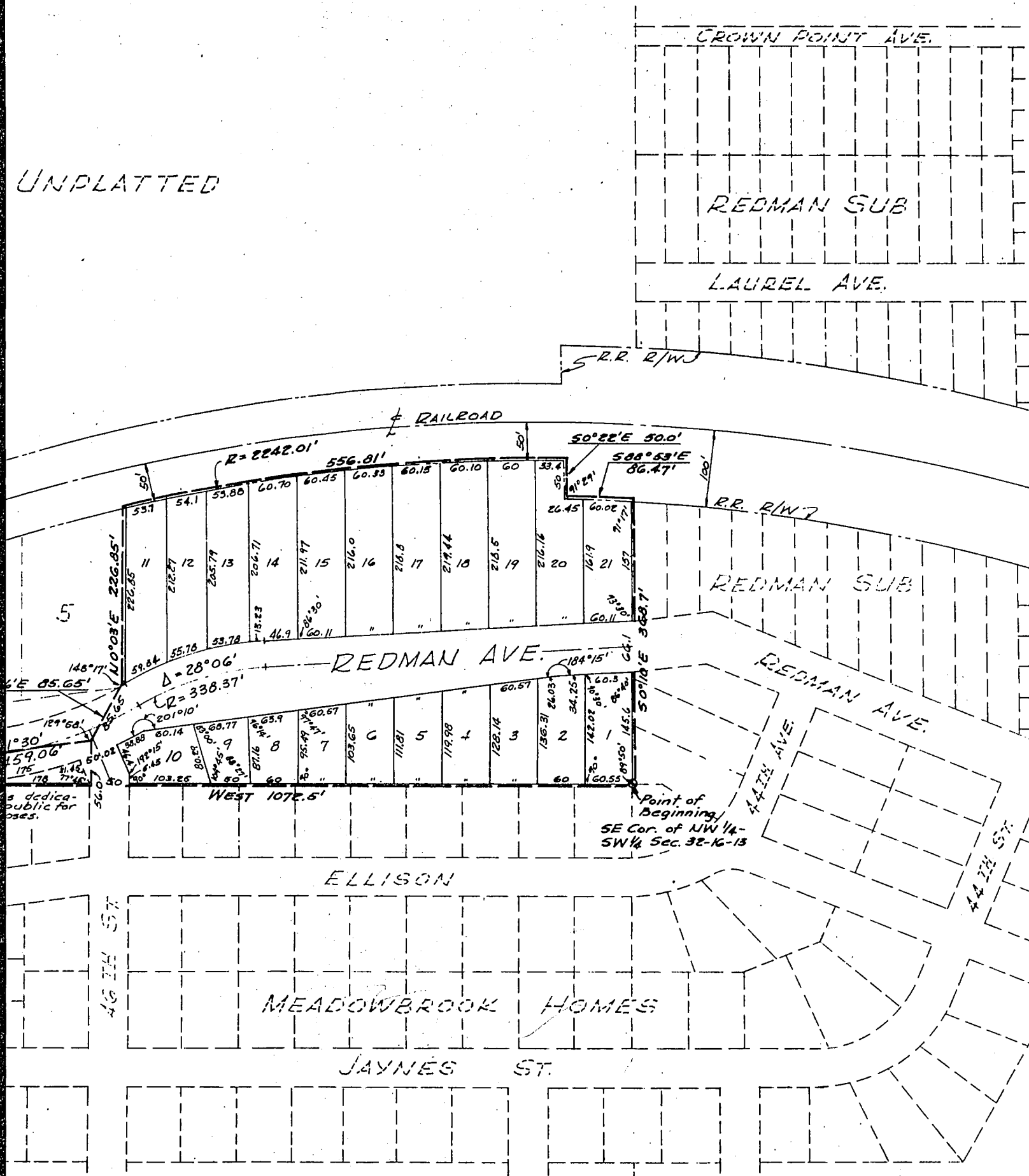
