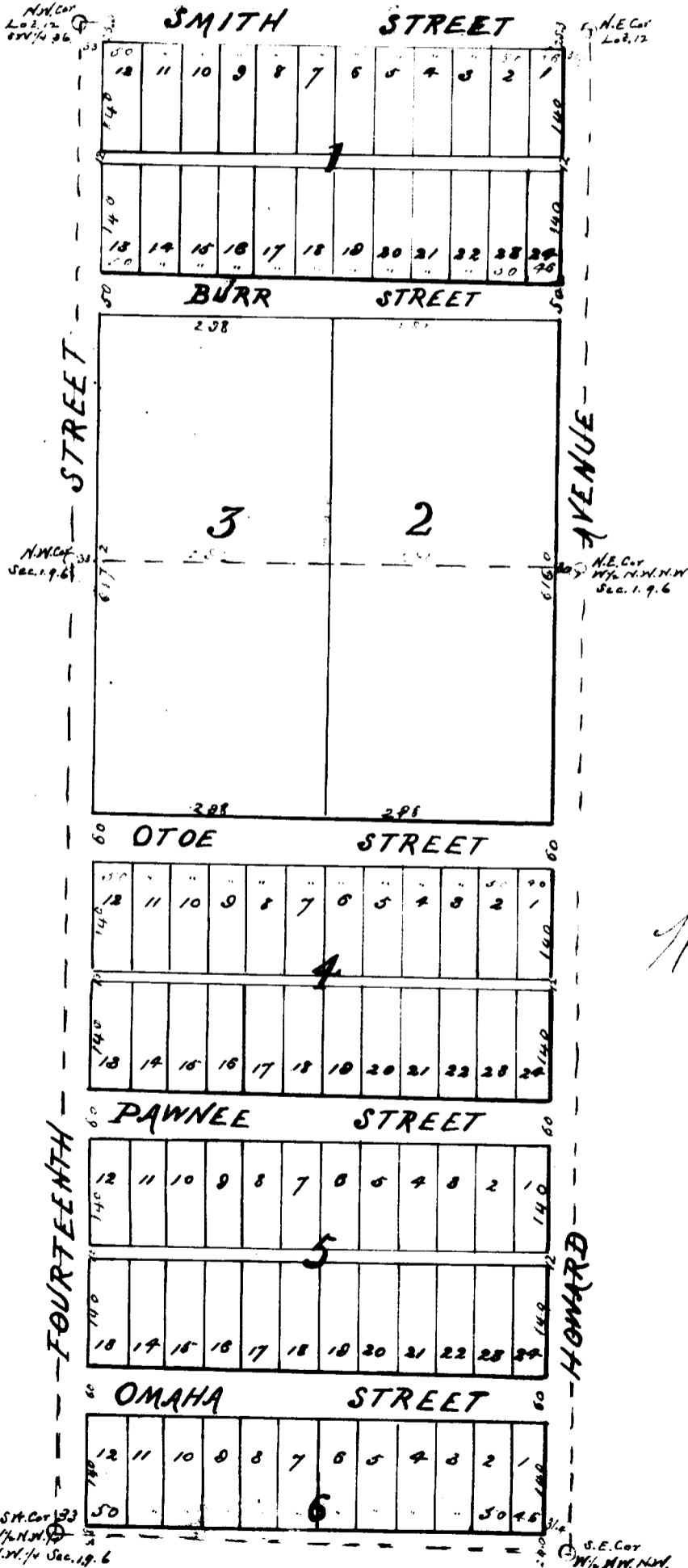

I hereby certify that I have surveyed and staked off into blocks, lots, streets and alleys, Knob Hill Addition to Lincoln as shown by the annexed plat.

The dimensions of all lots, streets and alleys are indicated in feet and decimals by red figures on the plat.

All North and South lot lines in Lot 12 in the S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 36, T. 10. N. R. 6 E. are parallel to the West line of said Section 36, and all East and West lot lines are parallel to the South line of said lot 12 in the S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 36.

All lot lines in the W.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$ , N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 1, T. 9. N. R. 6 E. are parallel to, or at right angles with the West line of said Sec. 1.

Coin stakes are set at all lot corners on the block lines.
