

VACATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the undersigned, Anna V. Olson, unmarried, Lena C. Brakine, widow, and Sanitary District Number One of Lancaster County, Nebraska, a public corporation, being the present owners of all of Blocks 17 and 19, Nearby Addition, located on the Northeast (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) quarter of Section Thirteen (13), Township Ten (10), North Range Six (6) East of the 6th P. M. Lancaster County, Nebraska, the plat of which was dedicated on June 11, 1887, and filed in the office of the County Clerk of Lancaster County, Nebraska, on October 21, 1887, and now appears of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Lancaster County, Nebraska, in Book 2 of Plats, at Page 176, do hereby vacate all that part of the recorded plat of said Nearby Addition not heretofore vacated, save and excepting only Theresa Street between the West line of 27th Street and the West line of 25th Street as now existing, and said Theresa Street as now existing between the West line of 27th Street and the West line of 25th Street shall continue to be a public thoroughfare. The specific description of the properties vacated is as follows:

Theresa Street from the West side of 24th Street to the West side of 25th Street;

Jeanette Street from the West side of 24th Street to the East side of 25th Street, and from the West side of 25th Street to the West side of 27th Street;

24th, 25th and 26th Streets, and the alleys in Blocks 17 and 19;

Lots 1 to 48, inclusive, being all the lots in Block 17, and

Lots 1 to 48 inclusive, being all the lots in Block 19,

all in said Nearby Addition.

Sanitary District Number One of Lancaster County, Nebraska, reserves a easement for the purpose of repair and reconstruction of existing sewers in Jeanette Street.

This vacation is authorized and made pursuant to Resolution No. 755 adopted by the County Commissioners of Lancaster County,

Nebraska on August 9, 1949, in which Resolution this vacation was specifically authorized.
