This document is made and entered into this 30th day of August, 1974, by and between JAMES H. FOWLER, hereinafter called "OWNER", and the DEPARTMENT OF UTILITIES of the CITY OF YACHT, DODGE COUNTY, NEBRASKA, hereinafter called "CITY".

One dollar and other valuable consideration (\$1.00) received whereof is hereby acknowledged, the OWNER hereby grants and conveys to the CITY, its successors, and assigns, the right to construct, operate, and maintain a line or lines for the transmission and distribution of electrical energy, including the necessary poles, towers, wires, cables, fixtures, appliances, guy wires, anchors, stakes and brace poles, along with the right to fell or trim trees, shrubs, or vines which may present a hazard to the safe operation of said line or lines through and over the following described real estate:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section 11 T17N R5E thence South 33 feet and West 33 feet to the corner of the road right-of-way, which is the point of beginning, thence South parallel with the section line to the North right-of-way of the Chicago & North Western Railroad, thence West 18 inches, thence North parallel to the foregoing mentioned section line to a point 33 feet South of the North section line of Section 11, thence East 18 inches to the point of beginning.

No guys or poles will be installed in the basement area until such time that adjacent private ground is sold or condemned for public use.

The CITY shall have the right of ingress and egress over the OWNER's property for any purpose necessary in connection with the construction, operation, maintenance and inspection of said line or lines, and shall be liable to the OWNER for any reasonable damage which may be caused in exercising this right.

The CITY shall protect and indemnify and save harmless the OWNER from all claims, demands, suits, judgments, costs, and expenses for loss, damages or injury to the person or property of any person or persons, having lawful right of being on the property, in any manner arising from or growing out of the construction, existence, or use of said lines, unless such loss, damage or expense shall be due to the negligence of anyone other than the CITY.
