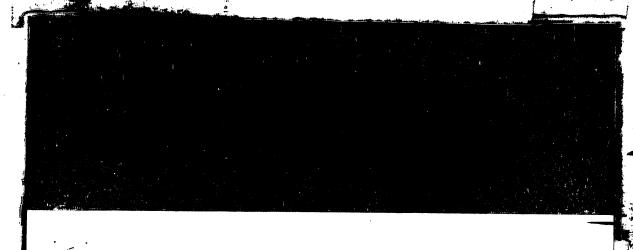

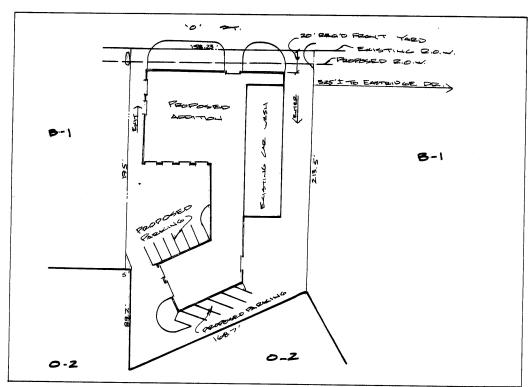


## Appeal 1846
