SPECIAL PERMIT NO. 19048

WHEREAS, 6135 O Street Car Wash, LLC has submitted an application designated as Special Permit No. 19048 for reconstruction of a nonstandard use with reduction of the rear yard setback from 30 feet to 15 feet while allowing vehicle driveways, drive aisles, and stacking in the rear yard, on property generally located at 6135 O Street, and legally described as:

The remaining portions of Lots 2, 3, and East 5' of the north 195 feet of Lot 4, Block 4, Eastmont 2nd Addition, located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 28, Township 10, Range 7, East of the 6th P.M., Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska;

WHEREAS, the Lincoln City-Lancaster County Planning Commission has held a public hearing on said application; and

WHEREAS, the property in question has been used as a car wash since 1969; and

WHEREAS, City records show that vehicle stacking was allowed in the required rear yard beginning in 1969; and

WHEREAS, analysis conducted by City staff indicates that reconfiguration of the site will result in more efficient traffic flow thereby not increasing the impact of the site on neighboring uses; and

WHEREAS, the community as a whole, the surrounding neighborhood, and the real property adjacent to the area included within the site plan for this reconstruction of a nonstandard use will not be adversely affected by granting such a permit; and

WHEREAS, the adjustments to the required setbacks are necessary to facilitate reconstruction of an existing building on the premises and will result in more efficient traffic flow throughout the site; and

WHEREAS, said site plan together with the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth are consistent with the 2040 Comprehensive Plan and with the intent and purpose of Title 27 of the Lincoln Municipal Code to promote the public health, safety, and general welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lincoln City-Lancaster County Planning Commission of Lincoln, Nebraska:

That the application of 6135 O Street Car Wash, LLC, hereinafter referred to as "Permittee", for reconstruction of a nonstandard use with reduction of the rear yard setback from 30 feet to 15 feet and a waiver to allow vehicle driveways, drive aisles, and stacking in the rear yard, on the property described above, be and the same is hereby granted under the provisions of Section 27.63.280 of the Lincoln Municipal Code upon condition that the development be in substantial compliance with said application, the site plan, and the following additional express terms, conditions, and requirements:

- 1. This permit approves the reconstruction of a nonstandard use, while reducing the rear yard setback from 30 feet to 15 feet and waiving the requirements of LMC § 27.72.060 to allow vehicle driveways, drive aisles, and stacking in the rear yard.
- 2. Before receiving building permits the Permittee shall cause to be prepared and submitted to the Planning Department a revised and reproducible final plot plan including 3 copies with all required revisions and documents as listed below:
 - a. Show and dimension all existing easements on the property.
 - b. Show the 20' front yard setback.

1	c. Add "Required Rear Yard Setback" above the "Proposed Rear Setback" text		
2	and note the 30' required setback in addition to the proposed 15' setback		
3	for which a waiver is requested.		
4	d. Identify parking on the west side as customer or employee parking and		
5	provide instrument number for any access easement from adjacent property		
6	for access to these stalls.		
7	3. Before receiving building permits the Permittee shall provide verification from the		
8	Register of Deeds that the letter of acceptance as required by the approval of the special permit		
9	has been recorded.		
10	4. Before occupying the dwelling units/buildings all development and construction		
11	shall substantially comply with the approved plans.		
12	5. The physical location of all setbacks and yards, buildings, parking and circulation		
13	elements, and similar matters must be in substantial compliance with the location of said items as		
14	shown on the approved site plan.		
15	6. The terms, conditions, and requirements of this resolution shall run with the land		
16	and be binding upon the Permittee, its successors, and assigns.		
17	7. The Permittee shall sign and return the letter of acceptance to the City Clerk. This		
18	step should be completed within 60 days following the approval of the special permit. The City		
19	Clerk shall file a copy of the resolution approving the special permit and the letter of acceptance		
20	with the Register of Deeds, filing fees therefor to be paid in advance by the Permittee. Building		
21	permits will not be issued until the letter of acceptance has been filed.		
22	The foregoing Resolution was approved by the Lincoln City-Lancaster County Planning
