Pettigrew and Frances G. Pettigrew as joint tenants but not as tenants in common, the following described real estate situate in the County of Douglas and State of Nebraska, to-wit:

Lot Two (2) in Block Four (4) in Lakewood Gardens a subdivision in Douglas County, Nebraska, as surveyed, platted and recorded.



Subject to the county, and state taxes for the year 1936, and all subsequent taxes and assessments; also subject to all installments of East Omaha Drainage District tax not yet paid.

Subject to the following restrictions and conditions:

- 1. No dwelling shall at any time be placed thereon with a ground floor area of less than μ_{00} square feet, exterior walls to be covered with drop siding or lap siding and painted, or of brick, cement or stone.
