

ORDINANCE NO. 8008

AN ORDINANCE declaring the West 30 feet of Block 2, and the West 30 feet of Lots 8 and 9, Block 3, Ralph Place, to be hereafter known as 43rd Avenue from Dewey Avenue to Emile Street, a public street and open for public travel.

WHEREAS, It has been duly declared necessary by Ordinance No. 7943 to exchange with the University of Nebraska certain parts of Streets and Alleys for certain lots, lands and real estate, in the City of Omaha, for street purposes; and

WHEREAS, All requirements of law relating to exchange of property have been complied with, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

Section 1. That the West 30 feet of Block 2, and the West 30 feet of Lots 8 and 9, Block 3, Ralph Place, to be hereafter known as 43rd Avenue from Dewey Avenue to Emile Street, be, and the same is hereby declared a public street and open for public travel, and to be improved as may hereafter be ordered or required.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect fifteen days after its passage and be in force thereafter.
