James H. Bigelow's 4<sup>th</sup> addition to the Village of Geneva Neb

This is to certify that on the 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> days of April 1886 I made a survey and plat of lots for James H. Bigelow to be known as James H. Bigelow's Fourth addition to the Village of Geneva. Said plat of land is laid West and adjoining Jos H. Bigelow's first addition to the village of Geneva and situated on the West (17) Seventeen acres more or less of the SE (4) quarter of the NW (4) quarter and East (13) Thirteen acres more or less of the SW (4) quarter of the SW (4) quarter of Sec (36) Thirty-six, Town (7) Seven North of Range (3) Three West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Fillmore County Neb. State of Nebraska. Said Plat contains (30) Thirty acres more or less. The streets running N. & S. to wit Cleveland, Lyon & Cauby Streets are each 50ft wide, one correspond in width, and are a continuation of the same streets in Snowlers first addition except Cauby Street which is a new street. The streets running E & W are 100ft wide, and are a continuation of Court and Lincoln Street in the original survey of Geneva. Lots from 1 to 16 inclusive are each 118 x 262 ft. The lots from 17 to 30 inclusive are each 45 x 184 ft. The Alleys run E & W and are 16 ft wide. Stakes are driven at the corners of each block and lot. The lots are numbered as per plat commencing at the W. E. Corner of said survey
