Presents shall come, Greeting. Whereas Peter B.
Presumption of Glover of Lancaster County, Nebraska
Certificate of has deposited in the General Land
No 1271 Office of the United States a Certif
- isale of the Register of the land office at Lincoln
Nebraska, whereby it appears that full payment

has been made by the said Peter B. Glover according to the provisions of
the act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled, "an act making further
provision for the sale of the public lands" for the north half of the south
west quarter, and the south half of the north west quarter of Section
Fourteen in Township eleven, north of range five east, in the District of
lands subject to sale at Lincoln, Nebraska, containing One hundred
and sixty acres, according to the official Plat of the survey of the said lands
returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said
tract has been purchased by the said Peter B. Glover.

Now Know Ye, That the United States of America in consideration
of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in
such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these
presents do give and grant unto the said Peter B. Glover and to his
heirs, the said tract above described, To have and to hold the same, togeth
er with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of
whatsaever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Peter B. Glover
and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I Wlyas. S. Grant, President of the
United States of America have caused these letters to made patent
and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Washington, the second
day of May, in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred
and Seventy, and the Independance of the United States the Ninety
fourth.
