BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND ISLAND, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. It is hereby found and determined by such City Council

- (a) The tract of land and streets and roads in the West One-Half of the Northwest One-Quarter (WhNW\$) of Section Seventeen (17), and the North One-Half (N\$) of Section Eighteen (18), all in Township Eleven (11) North, Range Nine (9) West of the 6th P.M., Hall County, Nebraska; and in the East One-Half of the Northeast One-Quarter (ENE\$) of Section Thirteen (13), Township Eleven (11) North, Range Ten (10) West of the 6th P.M., Hall County, Nebraska, as hereinafter more particularly described, are urban and suburban in character and contiguous and adjacent to the corporate limits of such City;
- (b) Police, fire, and snow removal benefits will be immediately available thereto; and City water service will be available as provided
- (c) The zoning classification of such tract of land and streets and roads as shown on the official zoning map of the City of Grand Island, Nebraska, is hereby confirmed;
- (d) There is a unity of interest in the use of such tract of land and streets and roads with the use of lots, lands, streets, and roads in the City, and the community convenience and welfare and the interest of such City will be enhanced through incorporating such tract of land and streets and rads within the corporate limits of such City.

SECTION 2. That the boundaries of the City of Grand Island, Nebraska, be, and hereby are, extended to include within the corporate limits of such City the contiguous and adjacent tract of land and streets and roads in the West One-Half of the Northwest One-Quarter (Wanwi) of Section Seventeen (17), and the North One-Half (Na) of Section Eighteen (18), all in Township Eleven (11) North, Range Nine (9) West of the 6th P.M., Hall County, Nebraska; and in the East One-Half of the Northeast One-Quarter (Eanes) of Section Thirteen (13), Township Eleven (11) North, Range Ten (10) West of the 6th P.M., Hall County, Nebraska, more particularly described as follows:

The east thirty-three (33) feet, except the north thirty-three (33) feet, of the Northeast One-Quarter (NEA) of said Section Thirteen (13); the North One-Half (NE), except the north thirty-buree (39) feet, of said Goution Elepheen (18); and the West One-Half of the Northwest One-Quarter (WENNA), except the north thirty-three (33) feet of said Section Seventeen (17), and containing 87.6 acres more or less.

SECTION 3. That a certified copy of this ordinance, together with a plat of such tract of land and streets and roads be filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Hall County, Nebraska.

SECTION 4. Such tract of land and streets and roads are hereby annexed to the City of Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska.

SECTION 5. Upon the taking effect of this ordinance, the police, fire, and snow removal services of such City shall be furnished to the tract of land and streets and mads herein annexed, and water service will be available as provided by law.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication within thirty days in one issue of the Grand Island Daily Independent as by law provided.
