ORDINANCE NO.1048

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ALLEY IN BLOCK 23 in SOUTH PARK ADDITION TO THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH, NEBRASKA, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND PROVIDING FOR REVERSION OF TITLE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH, NEBRASKA

SECTION 1. That, pursuant to the petition of the owners at law of property adjoining the following described alley, that the alley in Block 23 in South Park Addition to the City of Plattsmouth, be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. Such vacation shall be absolute, but shall be subject to all existing easements and franchises for public utilities.

SECTION 3. Title to said alley shall revert to the adjoining owners as provided by law.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
