




E  $\frac{1}{2}$  F streets are continuations of E  $\frac{1}{2}$  F streets in Lincoln.

All lots streets and alleys have dimensions as indicated in feet and decimals in red figures on the plat.

Black lines and figures indicate the lots of this subdivision.

Red lines and large red figures indicate the lots and blocks of Grant Addition.

Oak stakes are driven to the ground at all lot corners.

Stones are set at points marked thus ○
